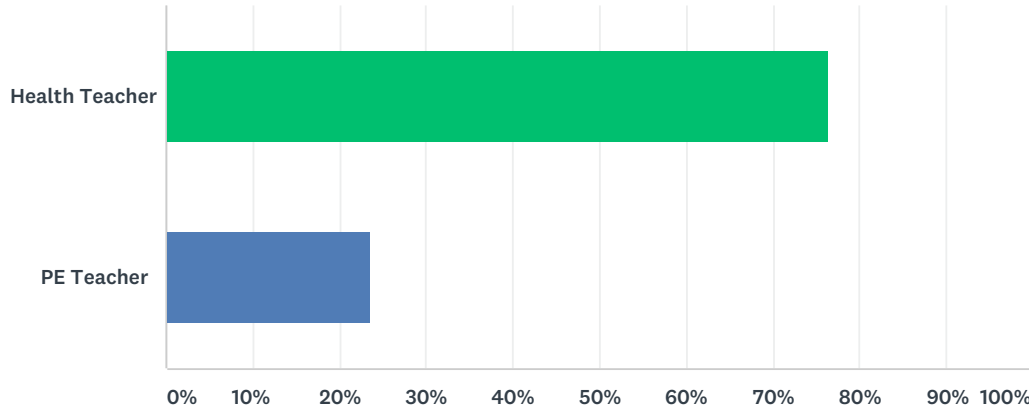

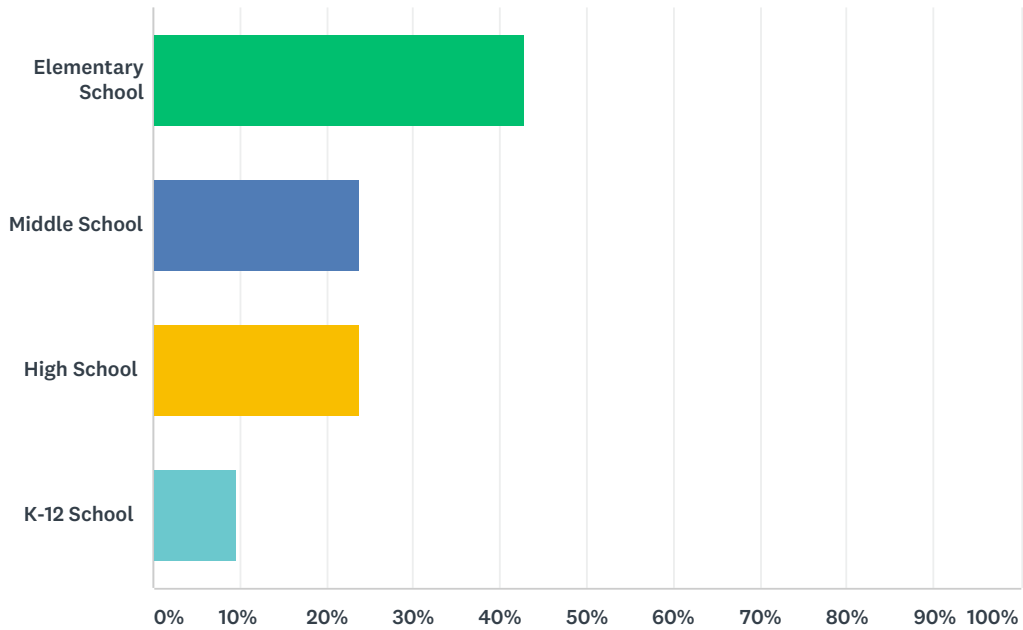

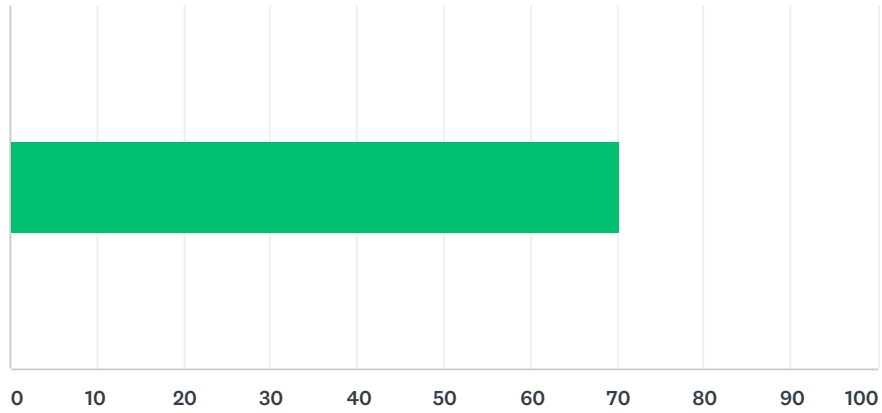

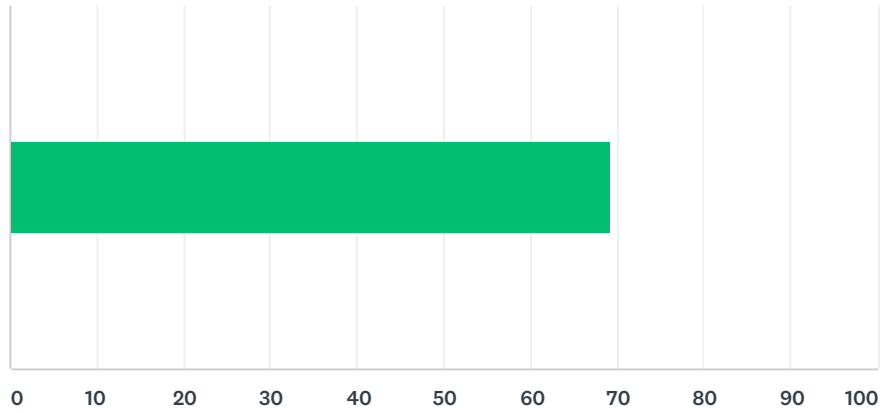

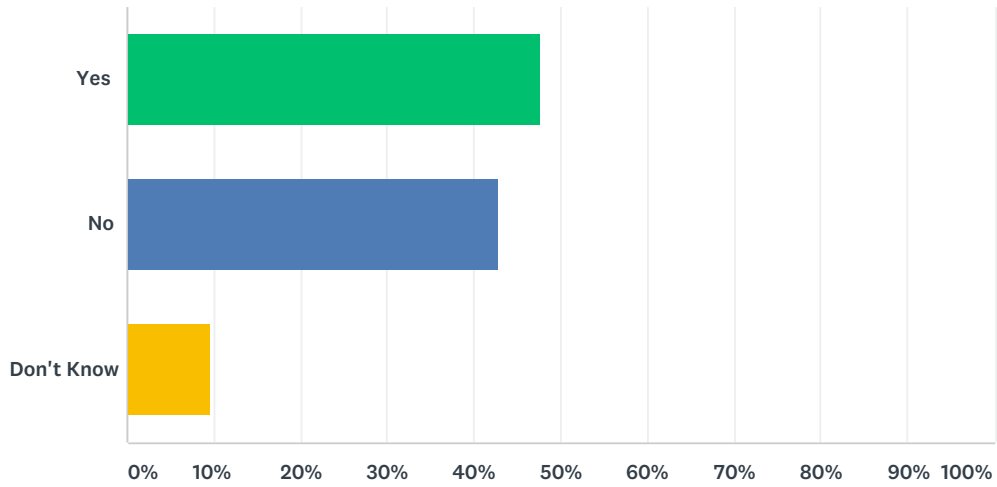

### Q7 Does your school use foods or beverages as rewards for academic performance or good behavior?

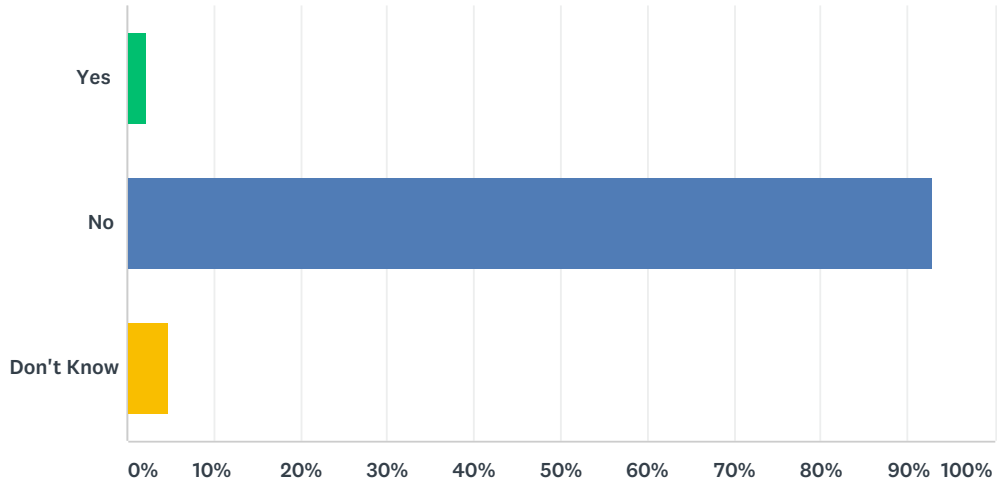

### Q8 Does your school withhold food or beverages as punishment?

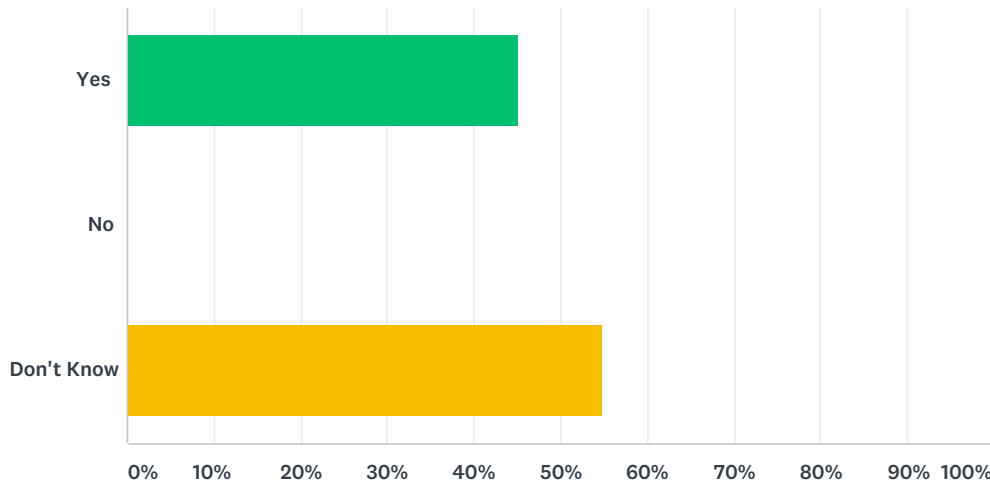

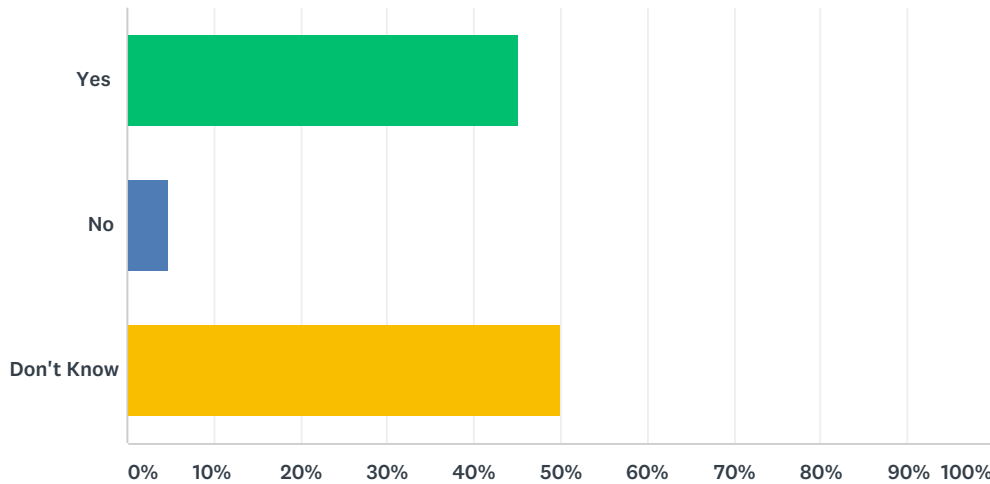

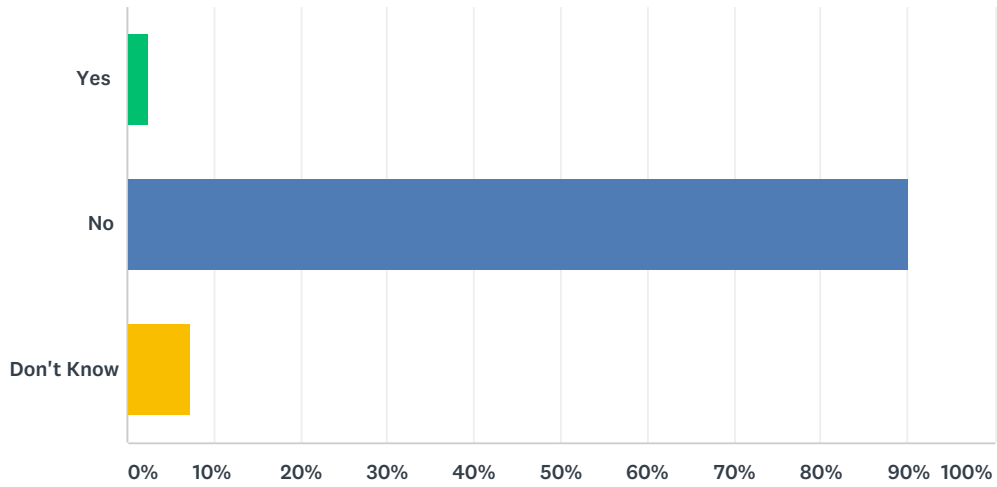

### Q11 My school uses physical activity as punishment (running laps, pushups, etc).

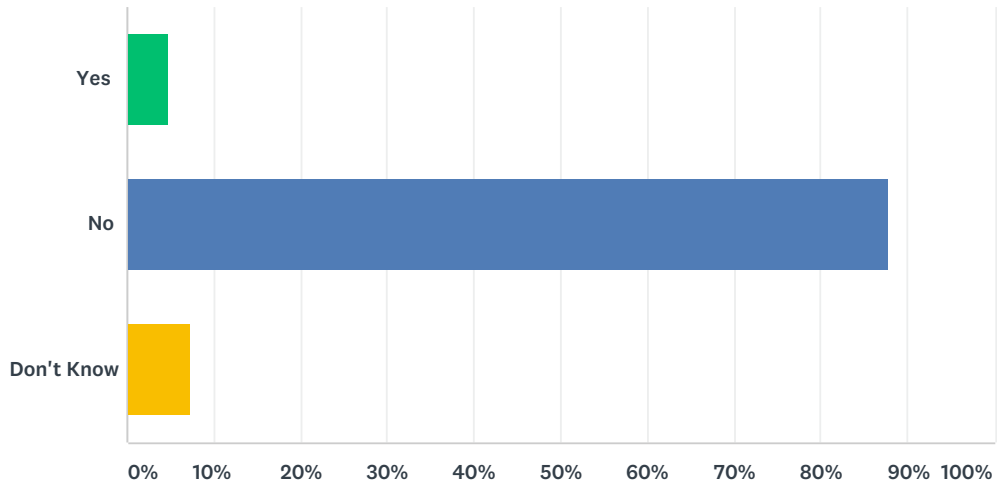

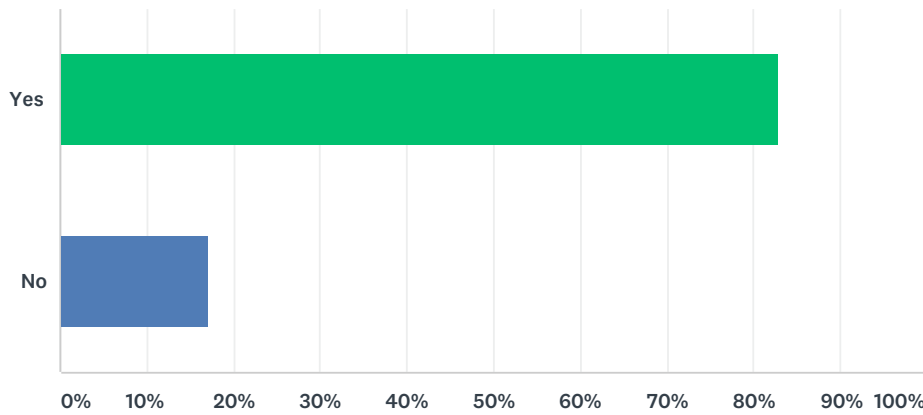

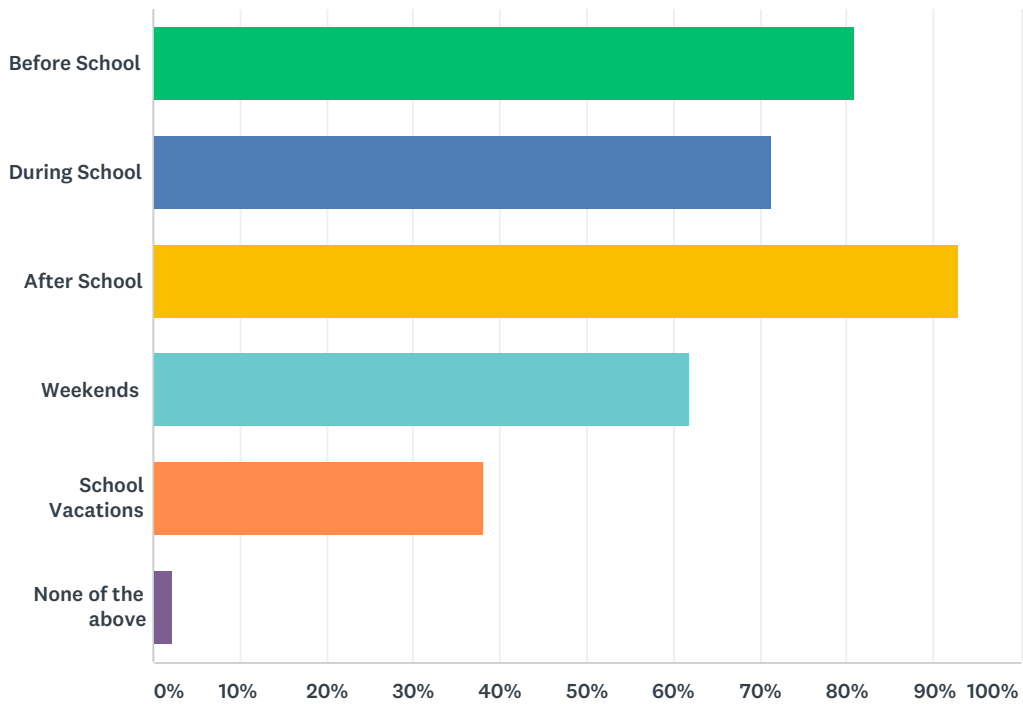

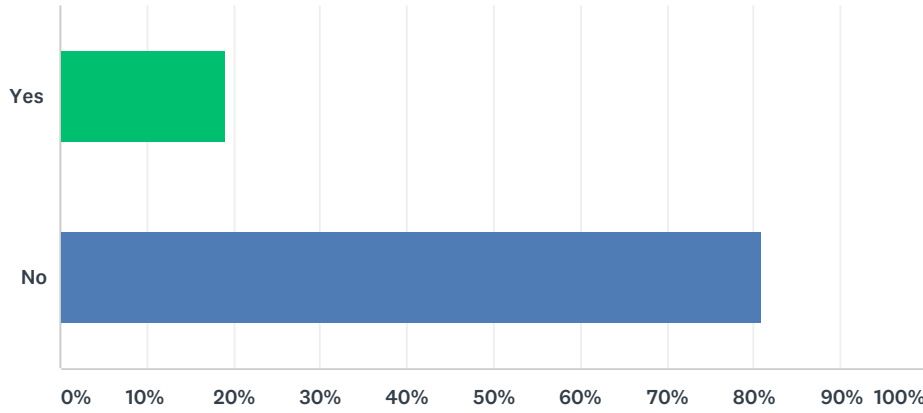

### Q15 Is your educational background in health education?

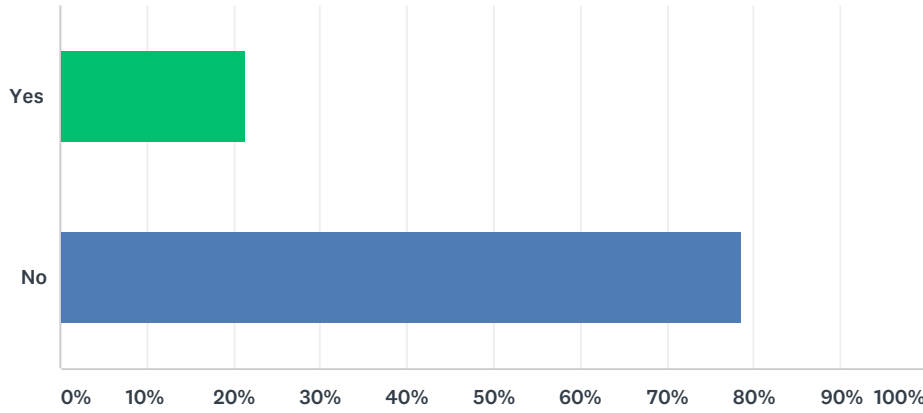

### Q16 Is your educational background in physical education?

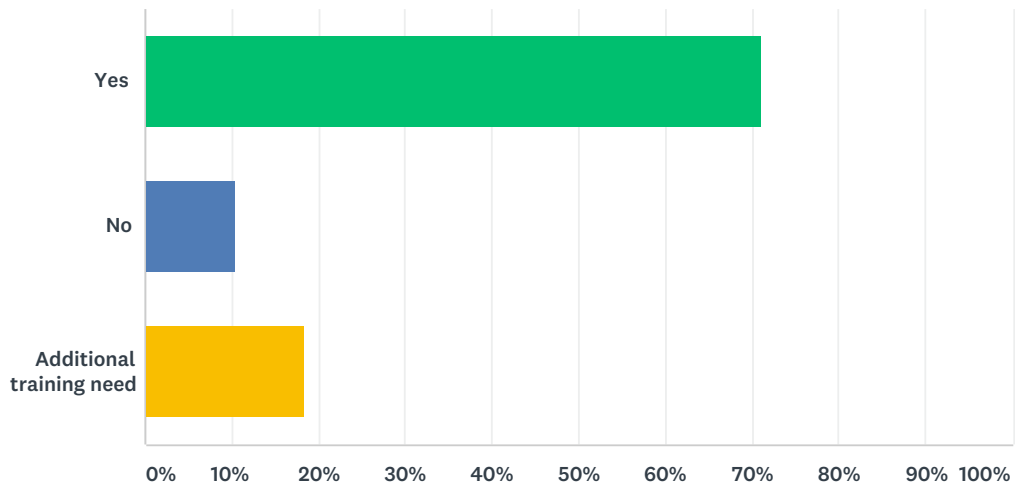

### Q17 Is there adequate training in Physical Education for you to implement those curricula?

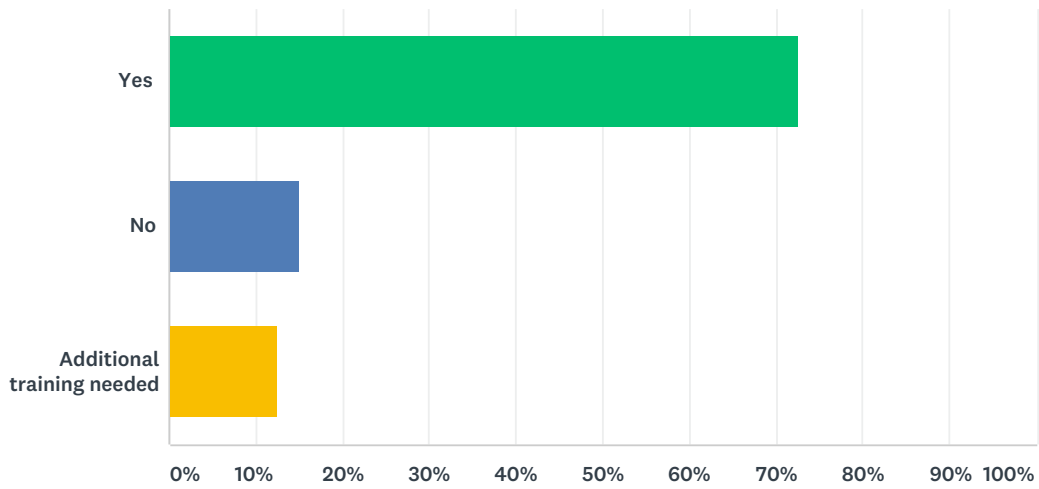

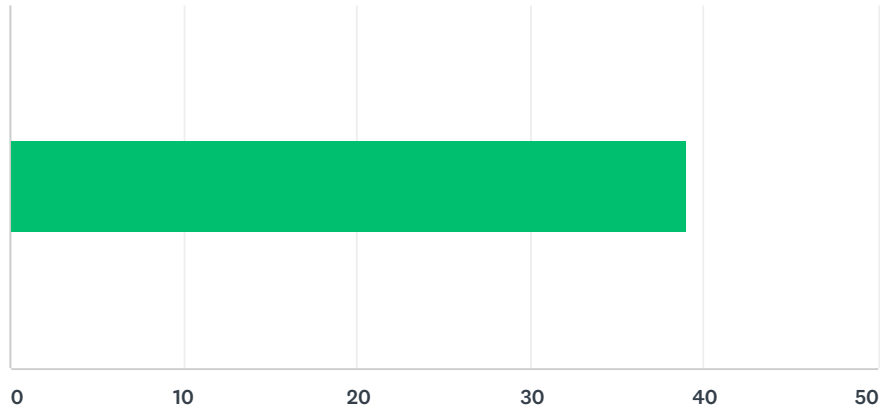
