Aging School Facilities:

1. All schools except Seward Middle School (built in 2006) are over 20 years old without a major renovation.
2. 11 Schools have portions of their facilities over 50 years old (prior to 1968). Moose pass is oldest with first active portion of their facility built in 1935.
 - a. Moose Pass built in 1935 with additions in 1953; 1960; 1974; 1987 and 1993
 - b. Kenai Alternative built in 1949
 - c. Sterling Elementary built in 1958 with additions in 1961; 1963; 1978 and 1983
 - d. Chapman Elementary built in 1958 with additions in 1969; 1978; and 1982
 - e. Tustumena Elementary built in 1958 with additions in 1969; 1978; 1983 and 1995
 - f. Soldotna Elementary built in 1960 with additions in 1962; 1968; 1975 and 1987
 - g. Nanwalek built in 1961 with additions in 1977 and 1984
 - h. Kenai Central High School built in 1964 with additions in 1967; 1968; 1975 and 1983
 - i. Paul Banks Elementary built in 1964 with additions in 1973 and 1984
 - j. Tebughna built in 1967 with an addition in 1976
 - k. Sears/Kaleidoscope built in 1968
