Students- ASSESSMENT (Evaluation of Student Achievement)

~~In partnership with students, teachers, and parents/guardians, opportunities should~~ shall be given for a student to demonstrate ability in all areas of a given subject. ~~Parents/guardians are encouraged to take an active role in the education of their student. The district shall provide opportunities for students and parents/guardians to self-monitor progress through the use of technology and direct parent/guardian teacher contact.~~ The evaluation of student performance will ensure that the student, teacher, and the parents can monitor progress toward the educational goals of a particular course of study. ~~Parents/guardians are encouraged to use PowerSchool's Parent Portal to monitor their students' progress, and call or email the teacher with any questions or concerns.~~

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Whenever it becomes evident ~~to a teacher~~ that a student is in danger of failing, or not proficient, in a subject, the teacher shall ~~send a written report, personally~~ contact the student's parent/guardian regarding the student's possible failure, and may request a conference with the student's parent/guardian.

No student shall be failed/not proficient in a subject unless ~~the his/her~~ parent/-guardian has been ~~notified~~ notified by ~~sent a verifiable~~, written notification and personal contact (i.e. phone call, email, text message) of the possible failure/not being proficient. ~~Teachers shall document all such contacts, and attempted contacts, in the district student management system, e.g. PowerSchool's Parent Contact Log. As partners in their child's education, parents/guardians have a responsibility to ensure their contact information is up to date in PowerSchool at the student's school site, so school personnel can contact them when needed.~~

Site administration will be kept informed and updated by the teacher throughout this process.

This policy shall be summarized in the Parent/Student Handbook annually. Employees will also be notified annually.
