5	C	West Homer El – North Wall Sealing Shortly after construction, the north wall constructed of fluted concrete block started allowing moisture penetration into the building. This has subsequently caused damage to surfaces, and has contributed to mold growth. 6	C	Homer HS Heating Controls Replacement The original heating controls were installed in 1985. The components are failing and the entire system needs to be upgraded to meet the current standards.
