

Mitigation Plan Overview for KPBSD Activities

As of September 4th, 2020, we have read through 126 mitigation plans for different activities on the Kenai Peninsula. These activities range from school sports, to community events, to private entities using a school facility (outdoor).

Out of the 126 plans

13 were submitted for Elementary Schools

11 for Middle Schools

86 for High Schools.

We have approved middle school and high school competitive sports including:

- Cross Country Running
- Swim Team
- Soccer
- Volleyball
- Cheerleading
- Football

We have also approved School Use mitigation plans for:

- PreK and Kindergarten Registration
- New Student Orientation
- Open Gym and Weight Room usage
- Locker Rooms and shower usage
- SATs
- Band and Drum Line
- Booster Club meetings
- Team travel plans, along with accommodations and food
- Concession and apparel sales – Pre-packaged (no try on or return)

We have worked with the community to provide a safe environment for their activities such as:

- Swim Team
- Aquatic Therapy
- Running Club
- Pop Warner Football
- Golf Fund Raisers – No Students
- Kasilof Public Library housed inside of Tustumena Elementary
- Board of Education Public Meetings

So far, we have approved plans for both Yellow and (limited) Red risk levels. There have only been a few submissions that were not approved or that were cancelled for various reasons.
