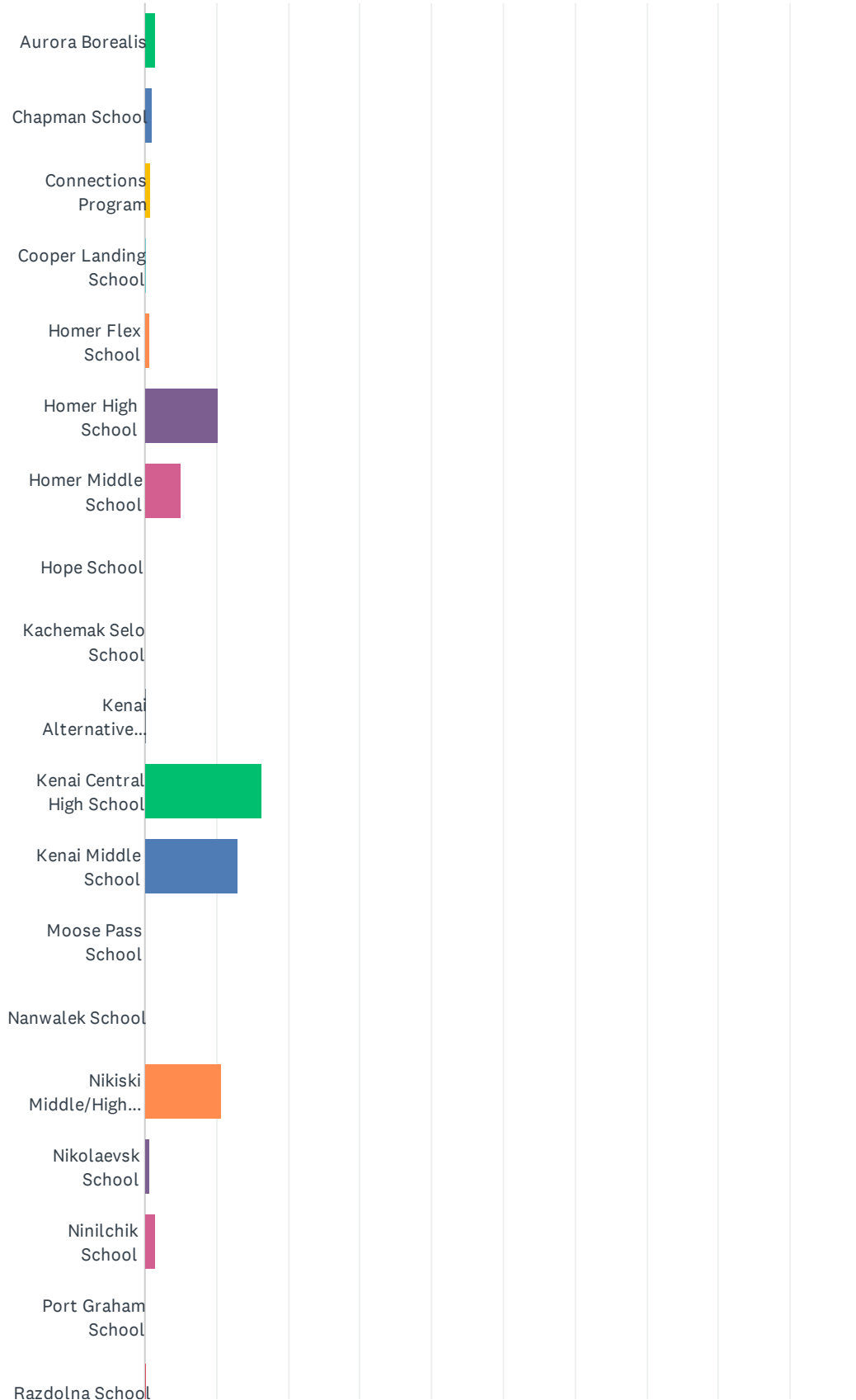
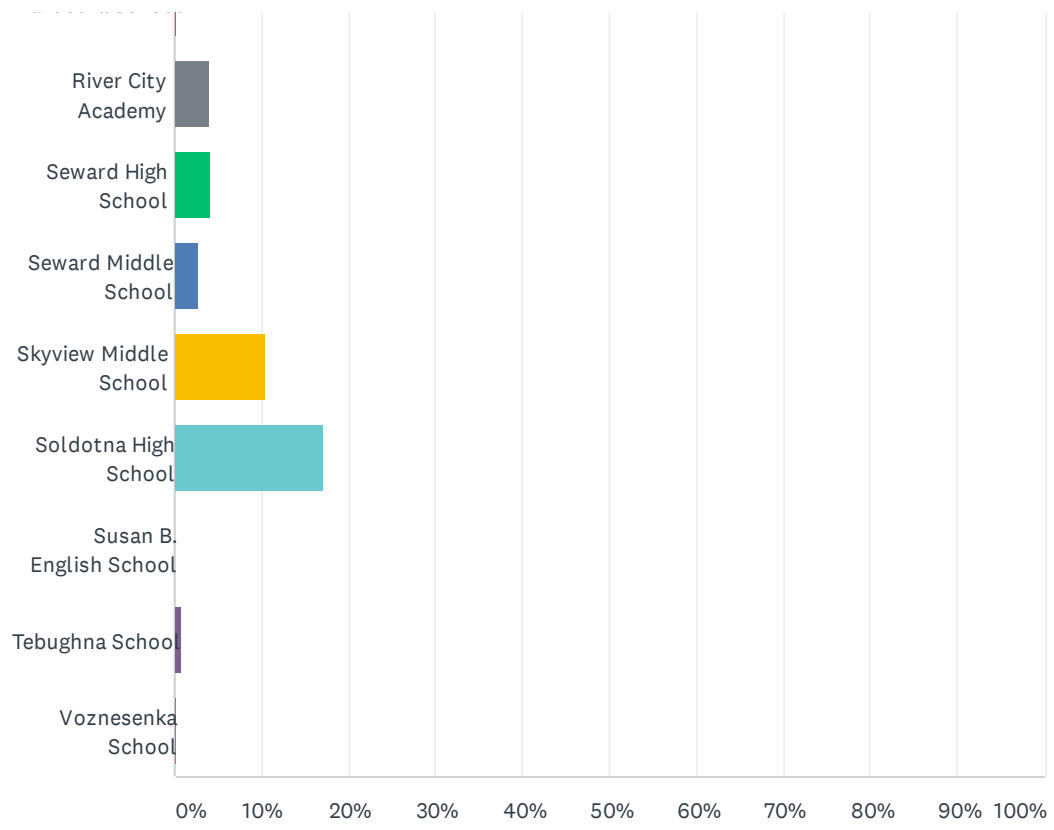


Q1 Which school do you attend?

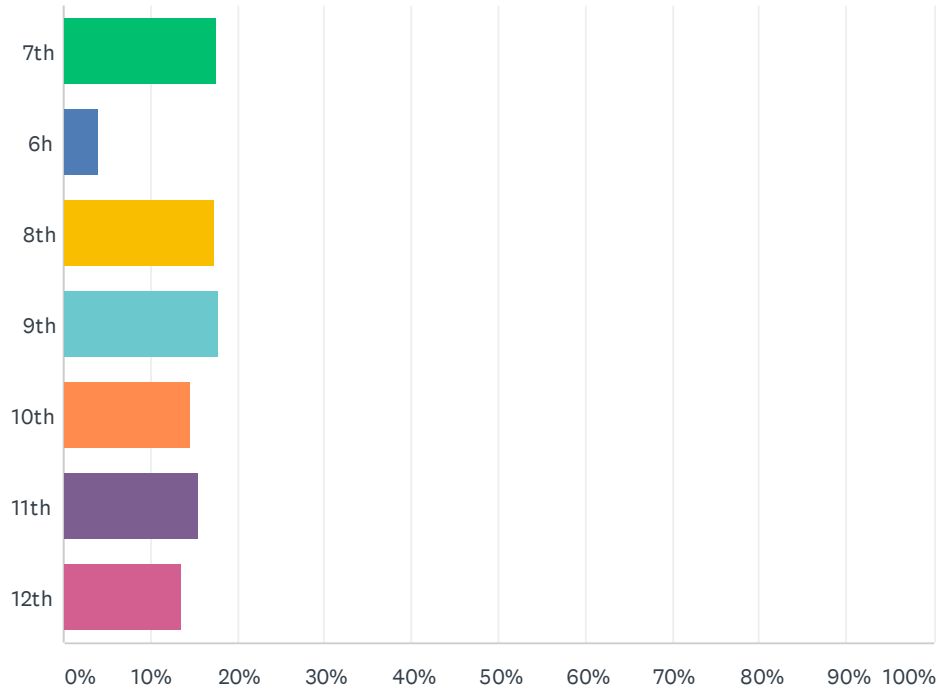

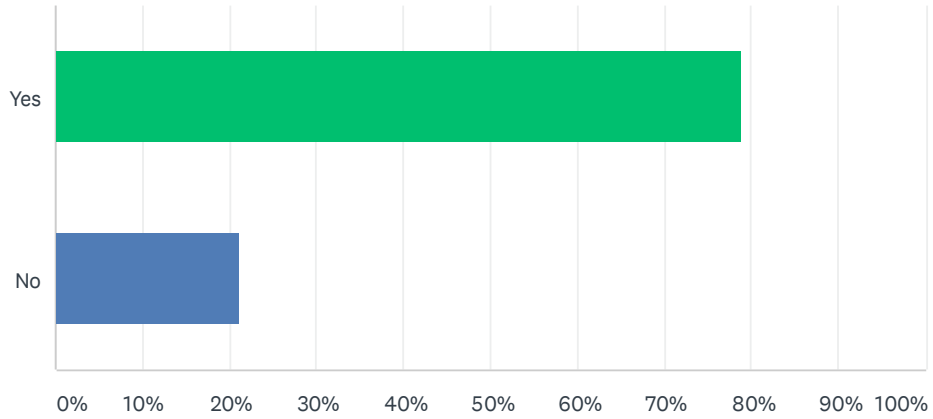

Q3 Prior to the community going to a Red-High Risk operation level, did you attend school onsite, in person?

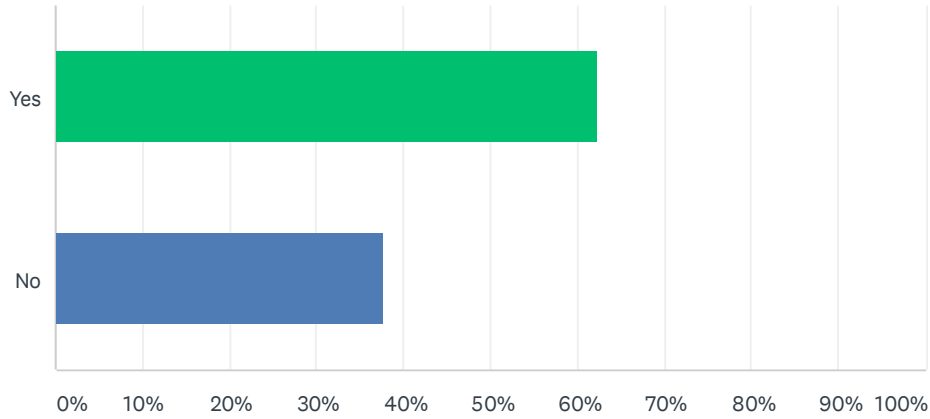

Q4 I would be comfortable bringing ALL students back into the building during Red High Risk operation levels.

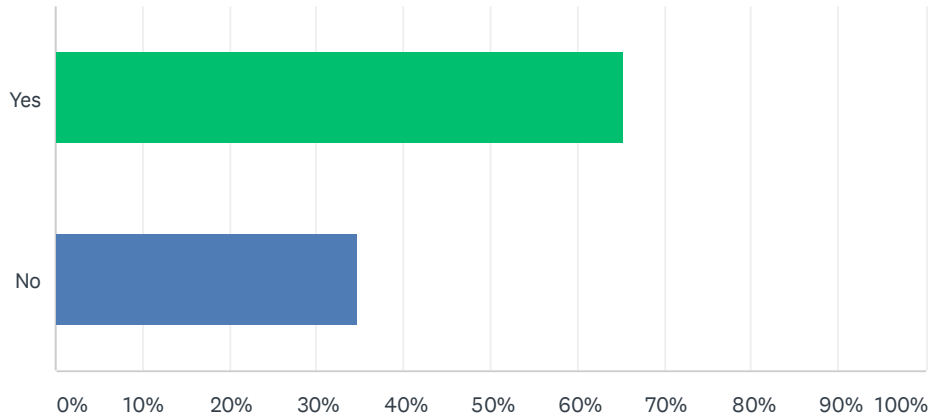

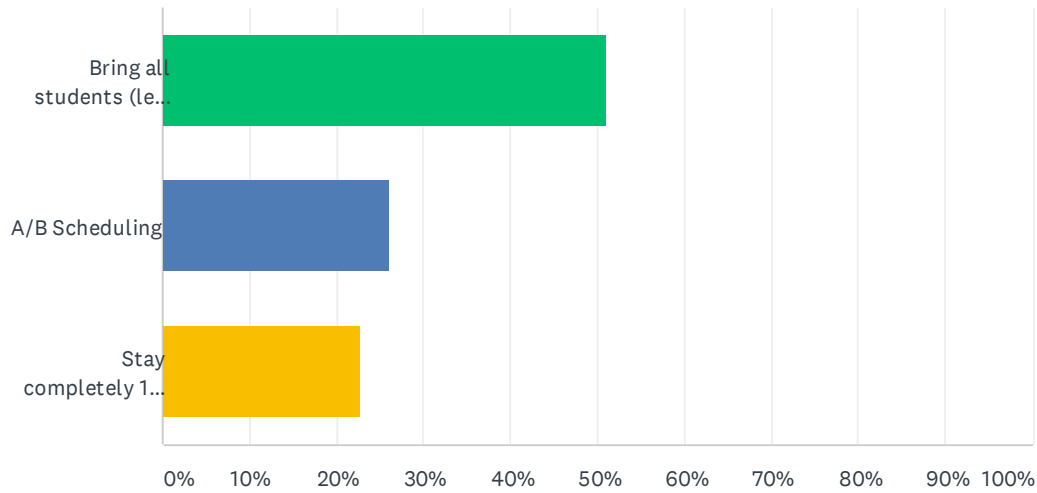
