Various assignments require the library as they research projects; compose music, and how to adapt to the changing markets of the arts.



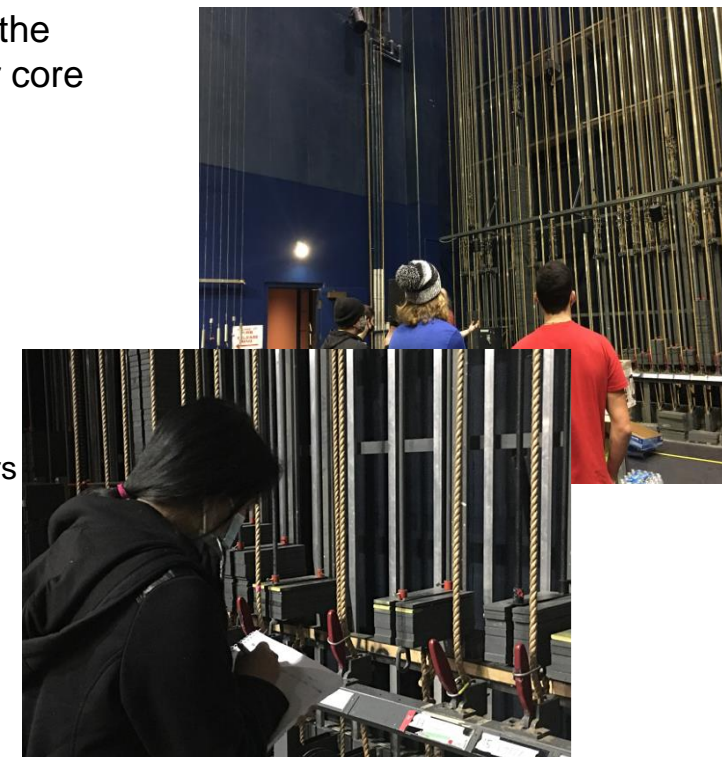

The technical side of music in the auditorium gives them the opportunity to study the interdisciplinary connections of their core classes in music, film, and theater.

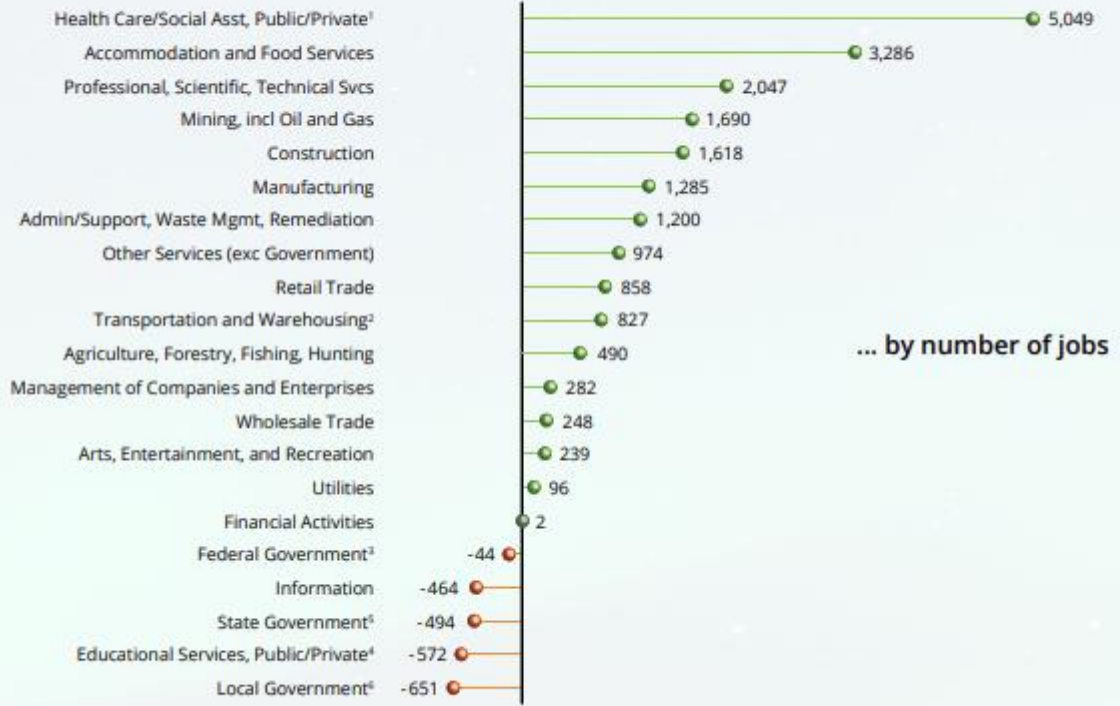


Rusty leads them through the unique spectrum of lights and color schemes.



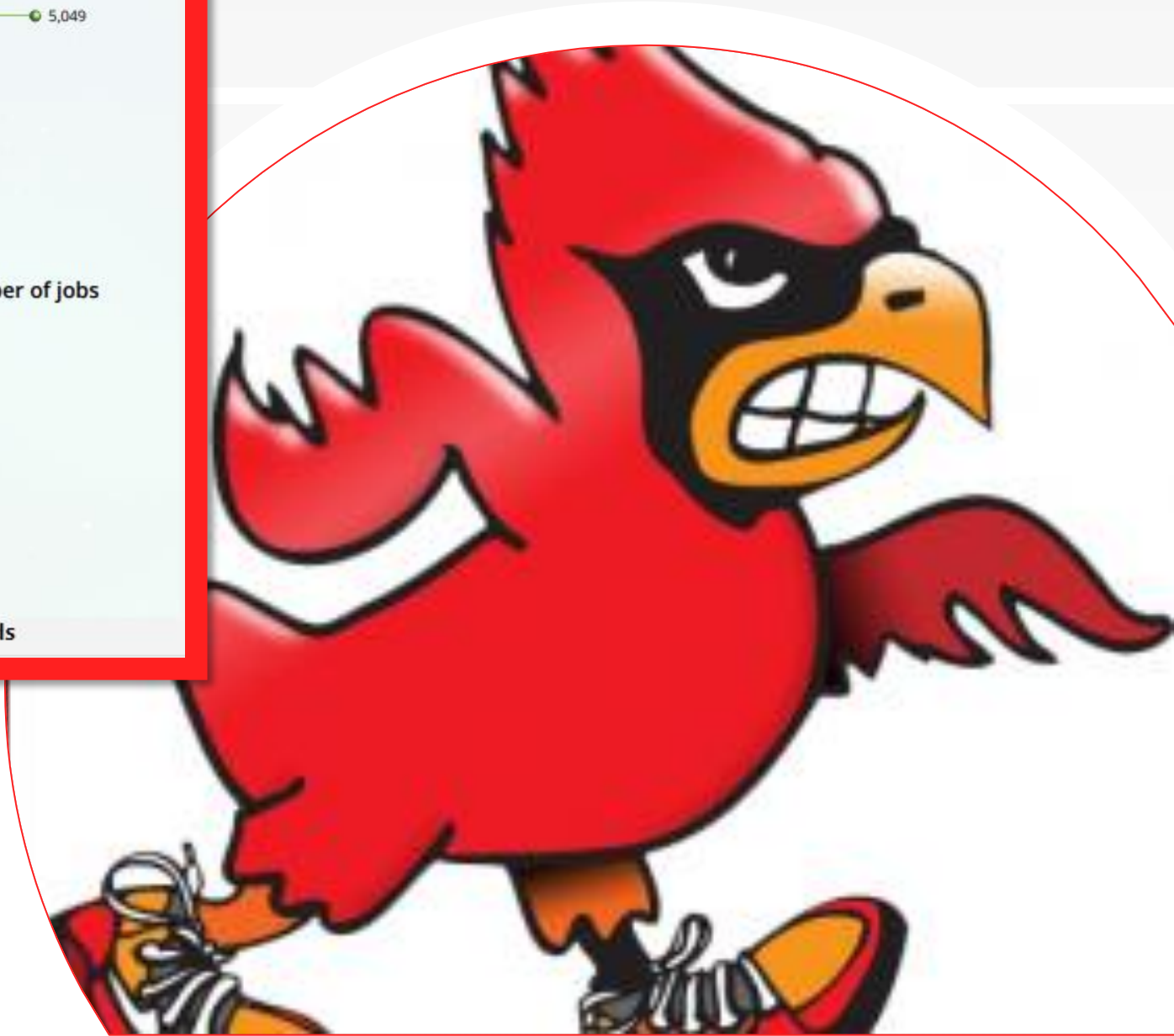
CTE Vision for the future

... by number of jobs

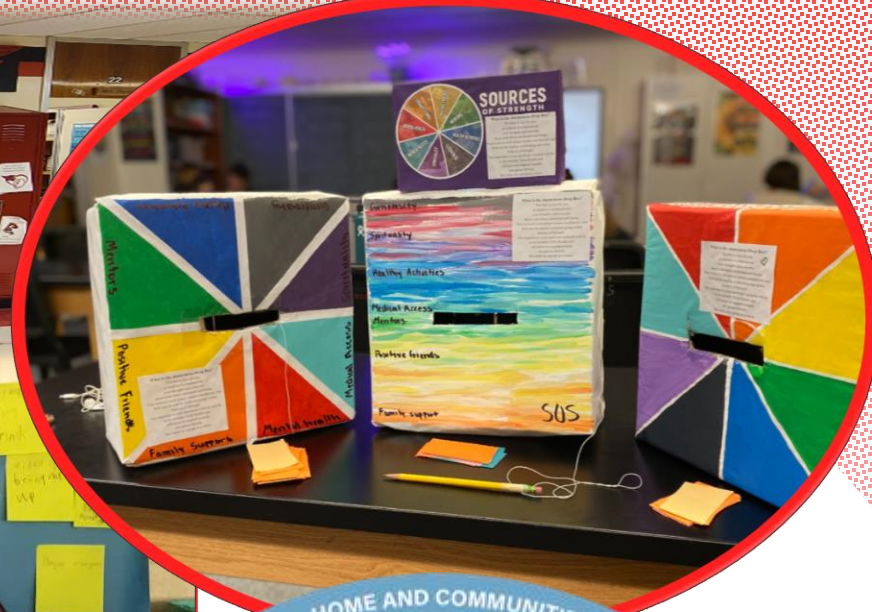

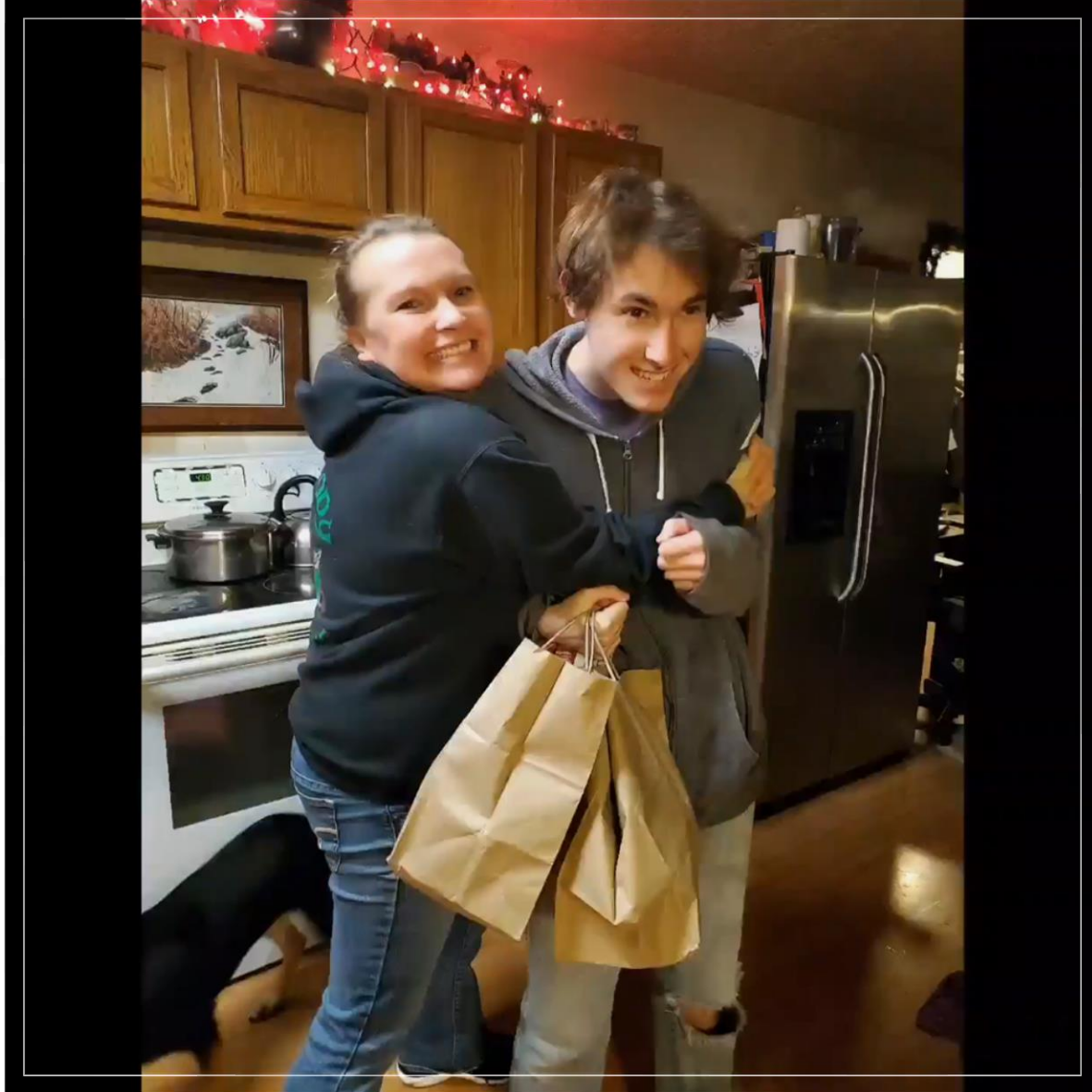
