Summer Program Application Process



Last March, principals were invited to work with certified staff to develop programming for their students.

Initially, K-3 Literacy boost was going to be offered regionally (Homer, Seward, Soldotna/Kenai) but many schools wanted to run a program at their own school site.

In addition to K-3 Literacy Boost, several teachers designed programs extended school year enrichment programs. Each program is unique and provides students with engaging activities to counteract academic slide.

Five Types of Summer Programs



- **K-3 Literacy Boost**
- **K-12 Physical and Social Emotional Wellness**
- **K-8 Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics**
- **9-12 Alternative High School Credit Recovery**
- **9-12 Traditional Credit Recovery**

K-3 Literacy Boost

K-3 Literacy Boost provides currently enrolled K-3 students receiving intervention services at their neighborhood school a continuation of instruction with enrichment activities.

Description: 4 hours of instruction, 4 days per week from certified teachers in the month of June.

School locations:

ABC, K- Beach, Mt. View, Nikiski
North Star, Paul Banks, Redoubt,
Seward, Soldotna, Sterling,
Tustumena

Enrollment:

- Students - 252
- Staff - 25 certified teachers



K-8 STEAM Programs

Teacher-developed STEAM programs provide students a wide variety of opportunities to explore science, technology, engineering, art, math topics in a fun, engaging format.

Description: Program length varied depending on teacher availability and availability.

School locations:

Skyview MS, Soldotna El, K-Beach El, Sterling El, Paul Banks El, West Homer El.

Enrollment:

- Student - 194
- Staff - 26 certified teachers



K-12 Physical and Social Emotion Wellness

Teacher developed physical education and social emotional learning programs provide K-12 students a wide variety of opportunities to exercise and foster social emotional strategies to be successful.

Description: Wellness programs to enhance opportunities for physical fitness and social emotional wellness.

School locations:

Skyview MS, Homer Flex, Homer HS, Soldotna HS, Tustumena EL

Enrollment:

- Students - 142
- Staff - 7 certified teachers



Alternative Credit Recovery

Highly personalized and individualized opportunities for HS students who barely failed core courses to review, relearn and redo important assignments and assessments in order to receive credit for their work.

Description: HS Credit Recovery opportunity for students who barely failed core HS courses.

School locations:

Nikiski, Ninilchik, Homer

Enrollment:

- Students - **coming soon!**
- Staff - 8 certified teachers



Traditional Credit Recovery

Traditionally, KPBSD offers high school students who did not complete classes they had started or failed the opportunity to recover credit during summer session. Certified teachers monitor student progress in a program called GradPoint. One of the key features of GradPoint for credit recovery is that it utilizes pretests for every unit to allow student to “test out” of various lessons. This allows students who may know the content, to work through coursework quickly.

Description: HS Credit Recovery opportunity for students using the GradPoint software.

School locations:

Nikiski HS, Soldotna HS, Kenai Central HS, Ninilchik HS, Homer HS

Enrollment:

- **Students - 158**
- **Staff - 8 certified teachers**
