Upstream is the Kenai Peninsula Borough School District's premiere STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math) Academy program. Upstream is a multi-year program designed for students at or below grade level. Throughout the program, Upstream connects students with STEM and future educational and career opportunities. Most academies are five days long. Academies can be held during the school year or in the summer.

- Problem Solving Current and Future Technology Issues
- Behavioral Health and Life Skills
- Higher Education Opportunities
- Career Education

Level One - Upstream Drone

Upstream Drone focuses on current and future drone technology and connecting students to their place in the STEM world through problem solving issues in the technology.

Level Two - Upstream Med Tech

Upstream Med Tech focuses on current and future medical technology. Specific focus Alaskan off-road wheelchairs, robotic prosthetics, as well as in-depth field trips to medical facilities. Upstream Med Tech is held in the winter.
