WHAT IS EDUCATORS RISING?



Educators Rising is a career and technical education (CTE) movement that aims to inspire high school and college students to serve their communities by entering the field of education.

School-based chapters are located almost in every U.S. state, where students practice the necessary skills to lead a classroom while adding student voice to National discussions around education.

- Recruit, Retain, and Develop** your own teacher pool
- Almost 60%** of teachers teach within 20 miles of where they went to school
- 51% of Educators Rising** students are students of color
