Using a set of rigorous criteria, WE will Identify the best K-5 Math Program to meet the needs of ALL our KPBSD K-5 students .

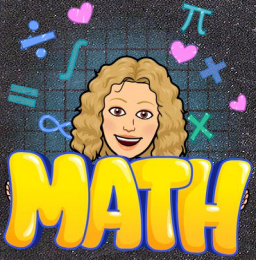
Session Success Criteria:

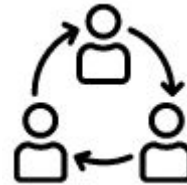

Do the instructional materials focus on the Alaska State Mathematics Standards for each grade level?

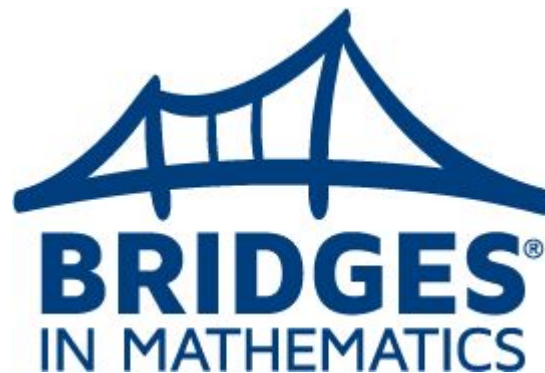
Gateway 2 - Rigor and the Mathematical Practices
