What is OASIS? On-Line Alaska School Information System. Also know as the twenty day count.

On-Line Alaska School Information System is operated by the Office of Assessments and Student Information in the Division of Teaching and Learning Support.

All school districts in Alaska participate in the "Twenty Day Count" beginning approximately October 1st every year and ending on the fourth Friday of October. Each student is counted at the school where they are enrolled and the numbers are forwarded to the state for verification. Through the use of the unique student identification numbers, districts are able to determine which students are "theirs" and which students have transferred to other districts or out-of-state. Once the counts are verified for actual students, the amount of time they are enrolled in school (full-time, part-time) is calculated by grade at each school in each district. Since the calculations include part-time students, they rarely add up to whole numbers and comparison of OASIS numbers with enrollment projections is problematic. For that reason, the OASIS calculations are reported separately with a comparison to current enrollment figures.
