RE: K-5 MATHEMATICS MATERIALS DECISION

The KPBSD K-5 Math Committee, comprised of 19 members (14 teachers, 2 principals, 2 instructional coaches and 1 district coordinator) completed final scoring of the programs Bridges and iReady mathematics programs. The [scoring rubric](#) used three Gateways to review the materials:

- Focus and Coherence
- Rigor and Mathematical Practice,
- Instructional Supports and Usability Indicators

The table below summarizes the results.

| Program | Gateway 1 (210 points) | Gateway 2 (270 points) | Gateway 3 (960 points) | Total |
|---------|---------------------------|---------------------------|---------------------------|-------|
| Bridges | 187 | 258 | 775 | 1,220 |
| iReady | 184 | 216 | 851 | 1,251 |

Additional key factors to support the adoption of iReady program:

- The iReady materials are adaptive and provide access materials in both physical and digital settings;
- iReady materials are usable in a general education, intervention, and special education classrooms;
- iReady provides an assessment dashboard that teachers, schools, and the district can use to analyze student math data.
