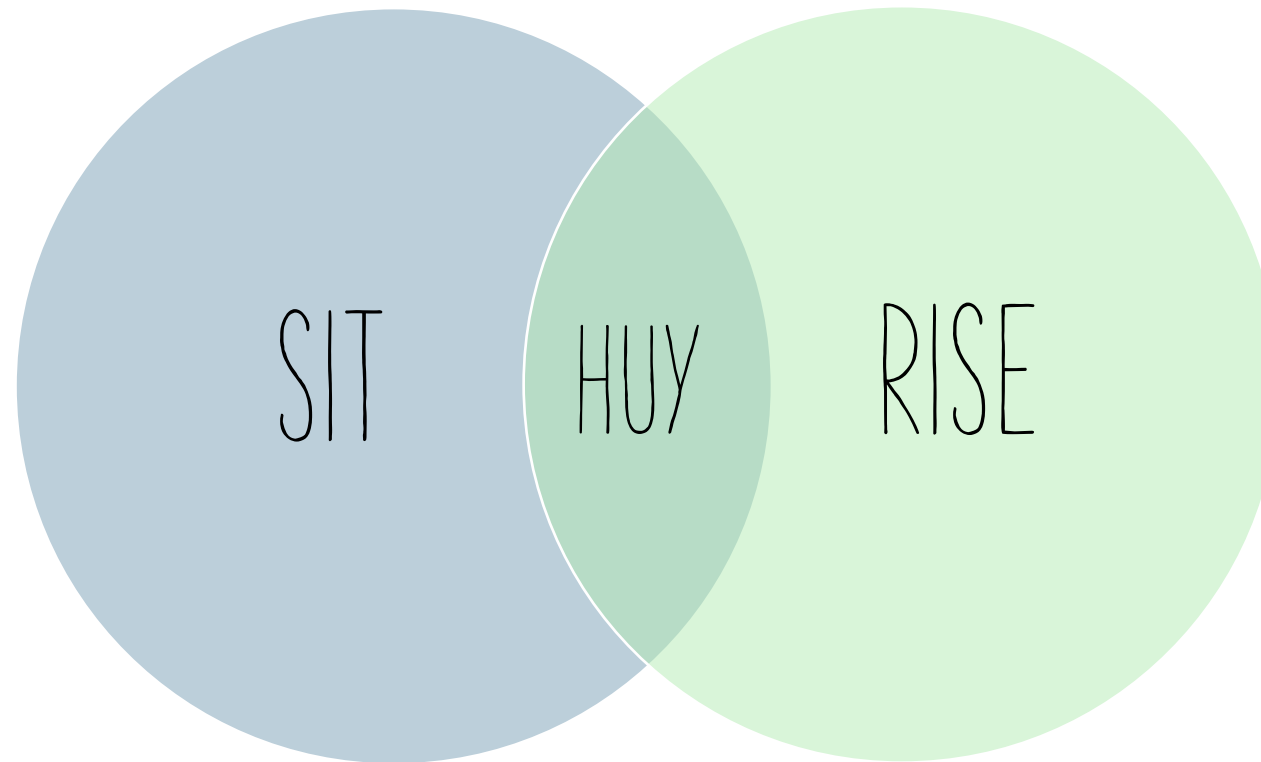


SIT and RISE Program Updates

SIT and RISE

- Removes barriers to education for students (all grades) meeting the Federal definition of "experiencing homelessness"
- McKinney-Vento subgrant, donations, ARP, and Title 1 set-aside funds

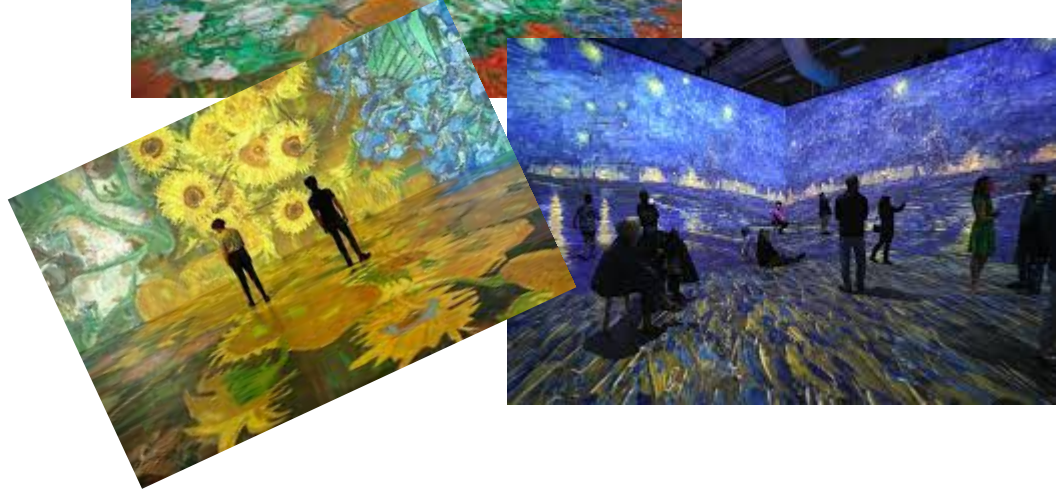
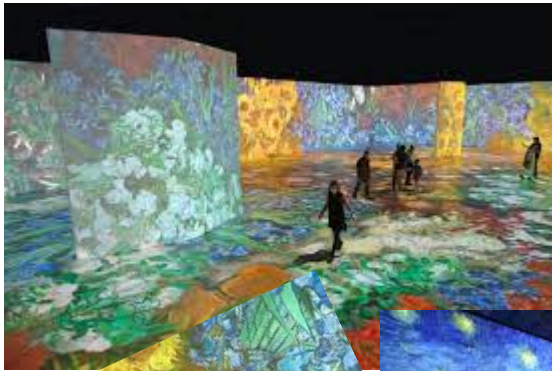


- Provides wrap-around services for middle/high school youth with multiple "at-risk" indicators
