~~The treasurer is the fourth officer of the Board for succession purposes, serves as one of three signatures on warrants authorized by the School Board, and signs all legal documents and notices as directed by the School Board.~~

The Board may use the services of private attorneys to meet the needs of the District. The Board-appointed legal counsel will render legal advice to the Superintendent or designee and the Board and perform other administrative duties as assigned by the Board and Superintendent or designee.

The Superintendent or designee may confer with the District's legal counsel at his/her discretion.

In utilizing legal counsel, the Superintendent or designee will obtain prior approval from the School Board before taking the following actions:

1. Committing the District to appear as a Plaintiff in a civil court action; or
2. Committing the District to a legal settlement for which it will incur obligations exceeding \$200,000.

The above requirements will not restrict the Superintendent or designee's discretion in administrative proceedings, nor in civil actions that arise as appeals from such proceedings.
