On January 23, 2023, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Purchasing and Contracting Department formally solicited proposals for RFP23-014 Soldotna Elementary School Education Specification. The request for proposals was advertised in the Peninsula Clarion on January 24, 2023, and the Anchorage Daily News on January 23, 2023.

The project consists of providing professional consulting services in an effort to complete an Educational Specification following the Alaska Department of Education and Early Development guidelines with the successful consultant also coordinating with stakeholders and end users to determine the needs for a new Soldotna Elementary School facility.

On February 21, 2023, two (2) qualified and responsive proposals were received and evaluated by an evaluation committee of qualified Borough and School District employees. The results of that evaluation are as follows:
