Strong school-community relationships require cooperative development and maintenance of efficient two-way channels of effective communication between the school and the community. District communications with the public should meet the following goals:

- ~~1. develop awareness of the existence and importance of diverse cultures in our communities and education; inform the public about the work of the schools;~~
- ~~2. improve the partnership of parents and teachers in meeting the educational needs and goals of students;~~
- ~~3. inform the public about the work of the schools; develop awareness of the importance of culture in education;~~
- ~~4. integrate the home, school, and community in improving educational opportunities;~~
- ~~5. clarify the aims, objectives, and work of the school; make school facilities and personnel available for community use, within limits set by the Board;~~
- ~~6. make school facilities and personnel available for community use, within limits set by the Board; partner with community resources to enhance educational programs; and~~
- ~~7. clarify the aims, objectives, and work of the school; make use of community resources in carrying out the educational program.~~

The Board encourages ~~school staff to foster relationships with community organizations and participate in community activities which align with the goals of the district's educational program. affiliation of school personnel with community organizations having missions consistent with that of the District, and encourages participation of school staff in appropriate community activities and projects.~~
