

Proposed changes for 2024-25 KPSAA HIGH SCHOOL Handbook As presented to the Board of Education:

KPSAA High School Handbook

1. *Page 10, STUDENT ELIGIBILITY, Section C. Item 1 b. Academic Progress*

Students determined to be ineligible at the mid-quarter check **based on their current cumulative grade** will begin their ineligibility on the *first school day* following the grade check until the next eligibility check. Students may regain their eligibility ~~after seven calendar days if they meet the 2.0 GPA and are passing all their classes within the next five school days.~~ **no sooner than the Thursday immediately following the initial mid-quarter check if they meet the 2.0 GPA requirement, are passing all classes, and turn in the regain eligibility form. Completed regain eligibility forms must be submitted during normal school hours. Students will be afforded seven calendar days from the initial mid-quarter check to regain their eligibility.** Otherwise, they remain ineligible until the next eligibility check.

Schools provided positive feedback in allowing students to regain eligibility after the mid-quarter check. KPSAA was not in favor of eliminating the mid-quarter check and instead proposed language to reduce the punitive nature by allowing ineligible participants the ability to regain eligibility before the weekend. It was noted we are the only district that uses mid-quarter eligibility checks.

2. *Page 16, PARTICIPATION GUIDELINES FOR ACTIVITIES, Section D. Participation Fees Item 1 & 2.*

(1) KPBSD has instituted an activity fee for all ASAA activities. The established fee for all **KPBSD enrolled participants in a high school activity** is \$200, with the exception of cheerleading, ESports, and performance dance, where the activity fee is \$100 per season. **The established fee for Non-KPBSD students will be assessed an additional \$200 to support an equitable contribution to facilities and operations per KPBSD activity.**

(2) The maximum participation fee assessed ~~any~~ **a KPBSD enrolled family** will not exceed \$700 per year at the high school level only. **The family cap would not apply to Non-KPBSD participants.**

Proposed language would provide additional revenue from Non-KPBSD participants that otherwise do not provide revenue to the district. Athletic teams are struggling to meet their financial obligations and sustain their programs.
