The KPBSD Board of Education Goals are intended to support the District and the District Strategic Plan.



GOAL 1. Support the District Strategic Plan in all Areas

- Review and develop policies that support growth in all areas of the strategic plan.
- Take actions that support and increase the number of students participating in dual enrollment and/or CTE courses.
- Increase the number of students who are proficient/advanced in language arts and who are making yearly growth.
- Increase the number of students who are proficient/advanced in math and who are making yearly growth.
- Provide the professional development and collaboration needed for staff to continually improve instructional practices and provide students needed with supports.



GOAL 2. Advocate Proactively for Predictable, Sustainable and Adequate Funding

- Communicate and engage with state legislators regularly.
- Increase awareness of the budget process, funding from the state, and how to advocate.
- Review the policy revision process and the education funding process/timeline for the public at each Board business meeting.
- Engage stakeholders in advocacy efforts.
