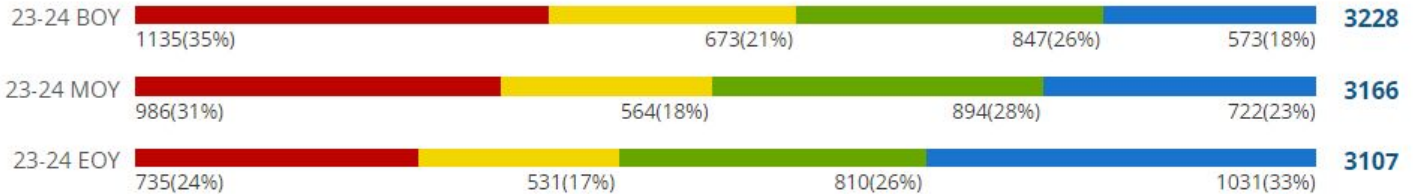

For 2023-24, the national mCLASS® per grade user base ranges from 500,000 students assessed (grade 3) to 700,000 students assessed (each of grades K-2). * For grades 4-5, the number of students assessed is smaller (~300,000 per grade), and more importantly, is often a collection of a subset of students within a school (as a secondary screener) rather than all students (as a universal primary screener) as is most common with grades K-3. Thus national data should be viewed with caution in these grades.
