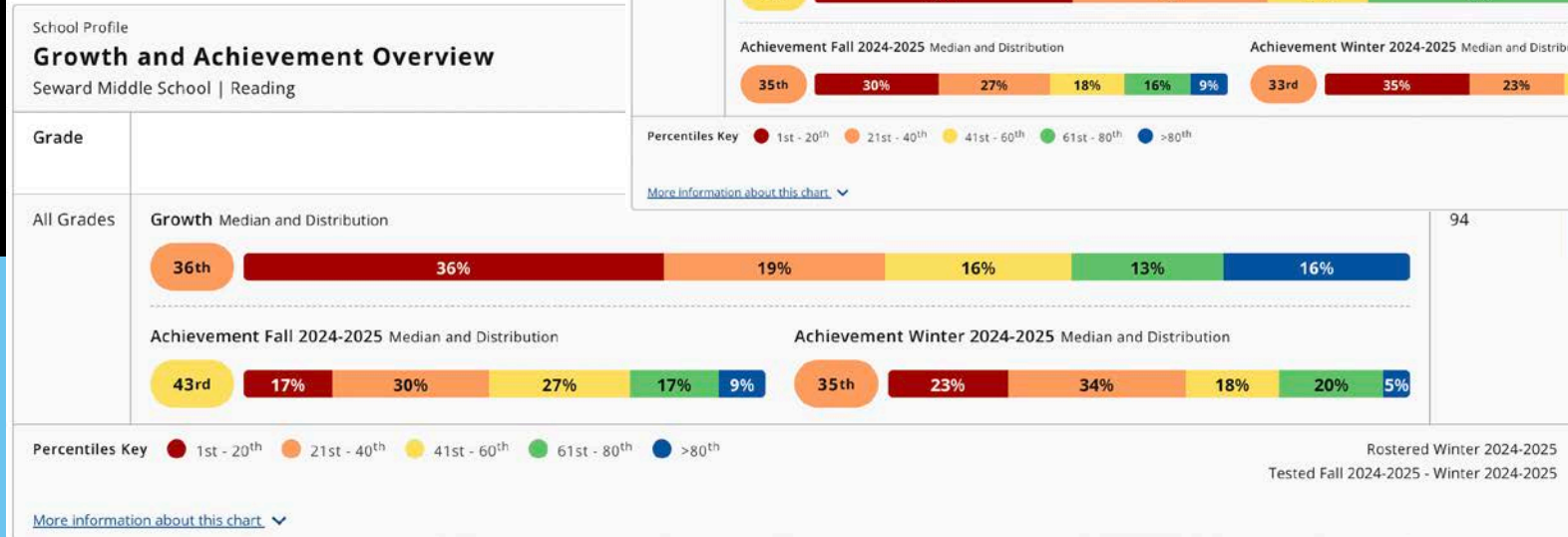




Math
