Short 2 paras for the first semester. (staff in place)

Lost the secretary 2 weeks into the school year. (We were able to find a great addition to our campus.)

Lost our school nurse. (recently was replaced.)

Pool was not functioning until January of this year.

Lack of subs. (combine classes or 1 sub)

Teachers teaching multiple content areas and grade levels.

No help for the kitchen when the kitchen manager is out. (principal and secretary prepare lunch and breakfast)

## Challenges

No music teacher (artist in the schools, community volunteers)

No PE teacher for elementary school (teachers teach)

No Librarian or library aide (next year we will have student aids)

No shop (CTE) teacher (currently have woodshop) (working with CTE director for intense classes)

Even with all these challenges our students have excelled. Ninilchik would not be successful without the staff, volunteers, community, NTC, and Project grad.

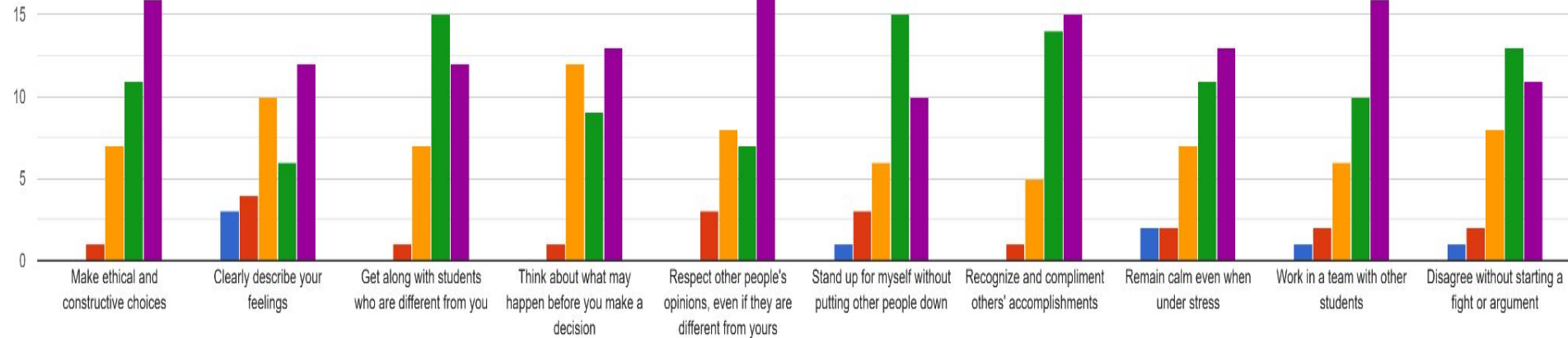

**Middle/High Basketball Skills-** All students are invited to participate in free practices twice a week to improve their skills all school year





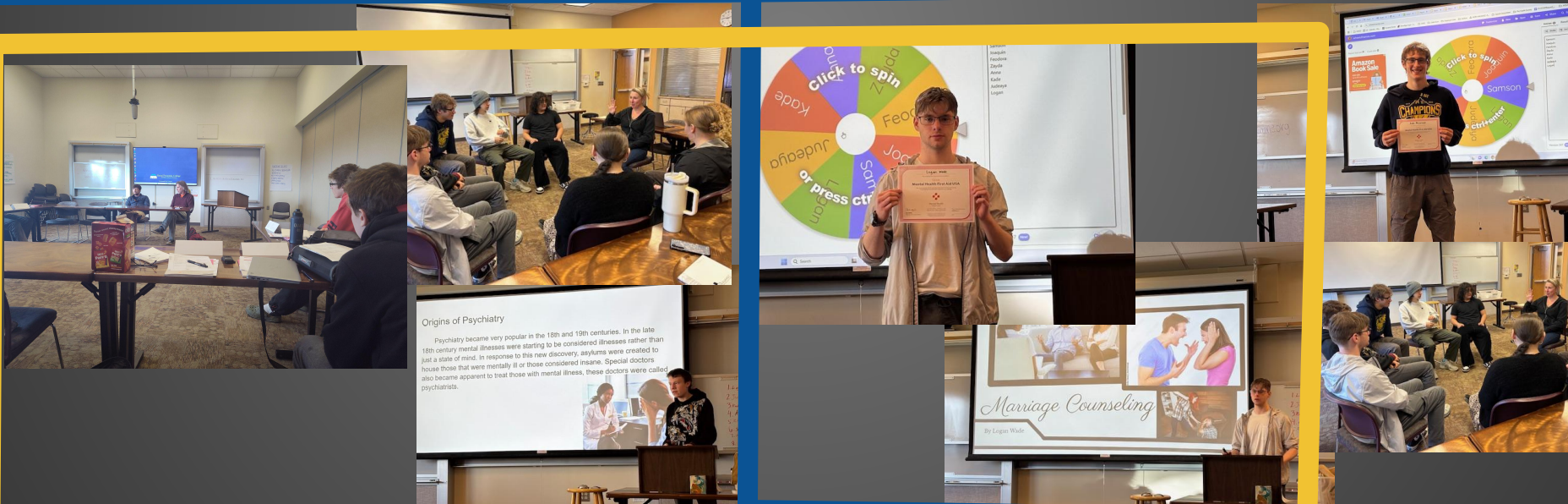
# Career Day
