SCHOOL GOALS

TITLE I AND SCHOOL DEVELOPMENT

Mountain View Elementary is a Title I school. At the end of the 2024-2025 school year, approximately 53% of students were considered economically disadvantaged.

In addition to these three originally established goals, Mountain View Elementary has also created an attendance goal:

By the end of the 25-26 SY, Mountain View Elementary will achieve an attendance rate of 93% or higher.

Literacy

By May, 2026, students who are present for 90% or more of the school year will maintain or improve their Reading percentile score from fall to spring on the MAP Growth Reading assessment to at least 75%, as a schoolwide average.

In kindergarten through 2nd grade, at least 80% of students will demonstrate early literacy success with a Composite Score at or above benchmark on the spring mCLASS assessment.

Safe & Secure Learning Environment

By May 2026, 100% of Mountain View's instructional staff will complete training in trauma-informed practices and inclusive practices for students with disabilities to strengthen Tier I instruction and support a safe, responsive, and inclusive learning environment for all students. Completion will be measured through training attendance records and follow-up implementation check-ins by administration.

Math

By May, 2026, 100% of kindergarten through 5th grade general education teachers at Mountain View Elementary will implement the required 40 minutes per week of I-Ready MyPath on-task lesson time for each student present at school. Progress will be monitored weekly and measured using PowerSchool attendance data and I-Ready MyPath usage reports, ensuring that all students who are present meet the required on-task time.
