- 24.74% of students receive Special Education service
- 21.07% of students receive intervention services

- 1% of students are English Learners

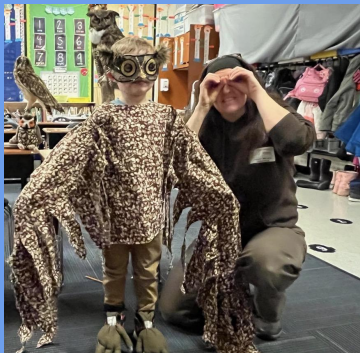
ACHIEVEMENT TREND- Winter 24–25: 61% —————▶ Winter 25–26: 61%
