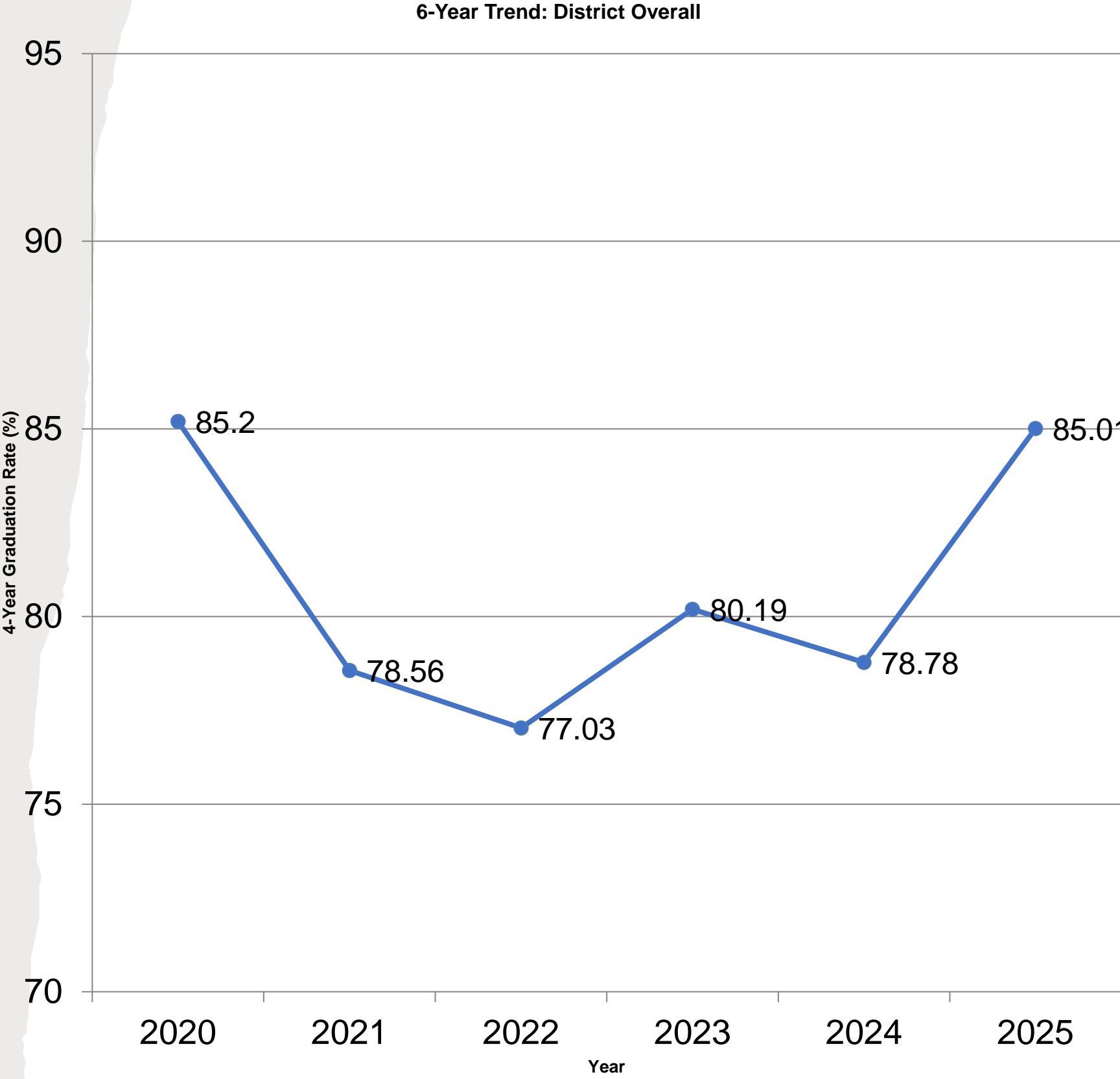

Six-Year Trend: Dip and Recovery

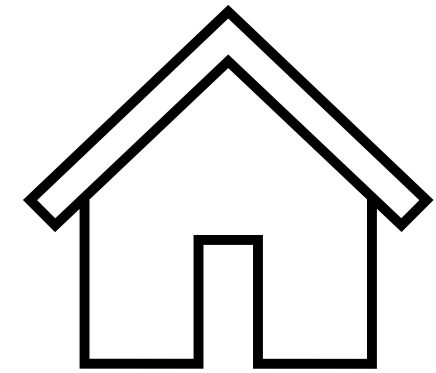
Districtwide 4-Year Graduation Rates

- 2020: 85.2%
- 2021: 78.56%
- 2022: 77.03%
- 2023: 80.19%
- 2024: 78.78%
- 2025: 85.01%



Graduation Gaps: Who We Are Worried About

- **Lowest-Performing Subgroups (2025)**
 - Homeless Students — 60%
 - Students With Disabilities — 64.41%
 - English Learners — 65.22%

- **These gaps have persisted across all six years.**

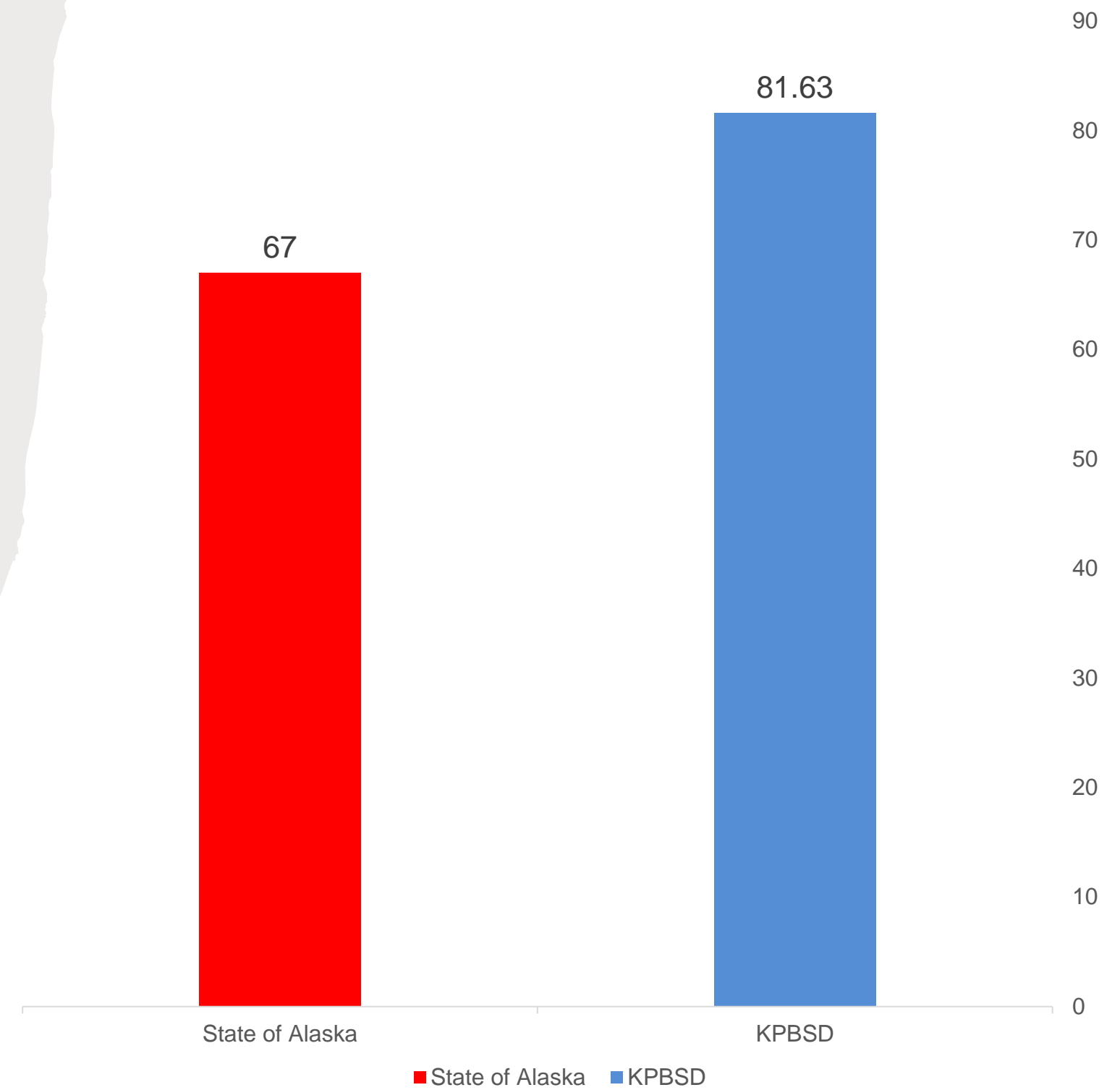


Alaska Native/American Indian Students

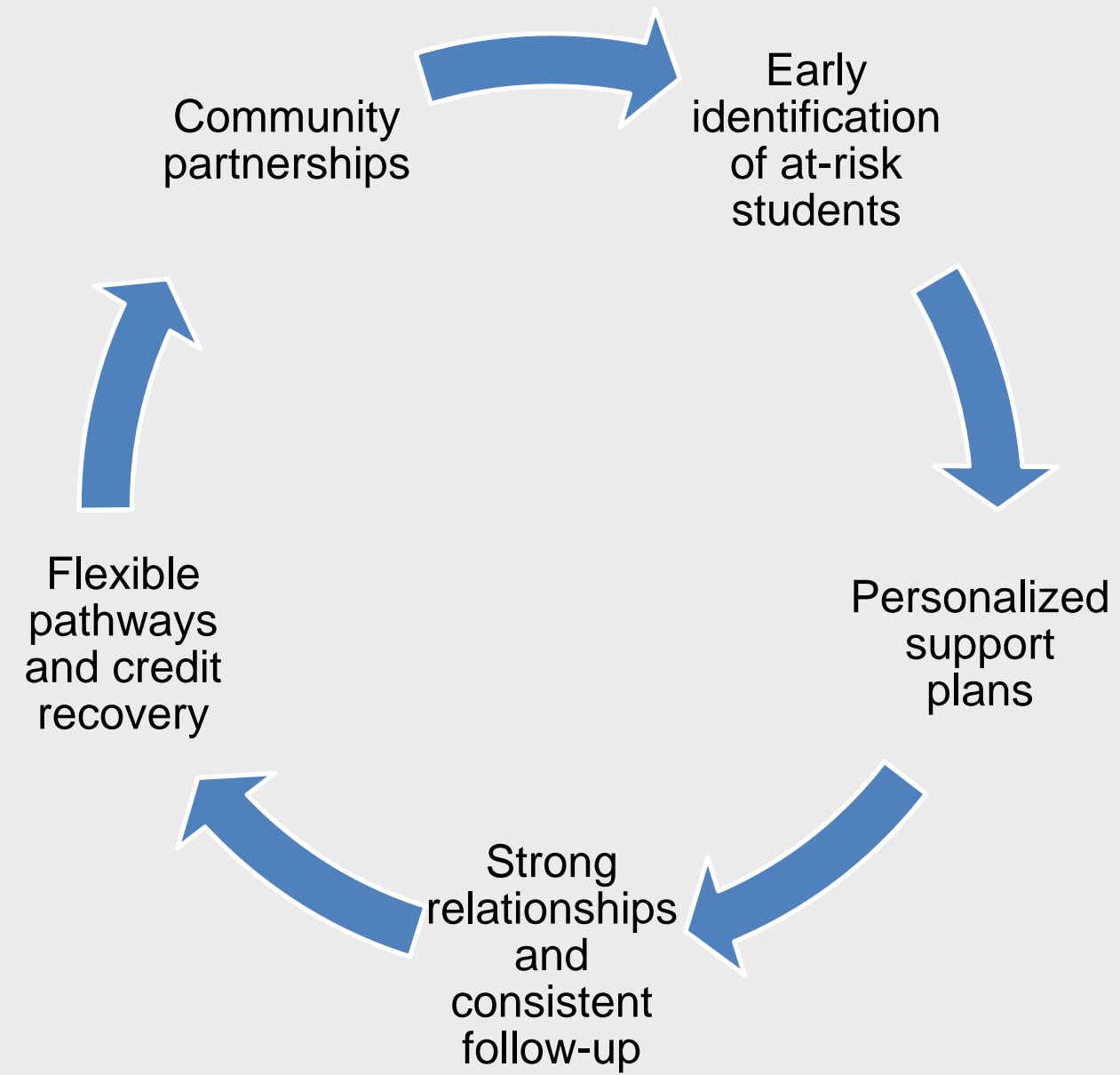
Strong Improvement Over Time

- 2025: 81.63%

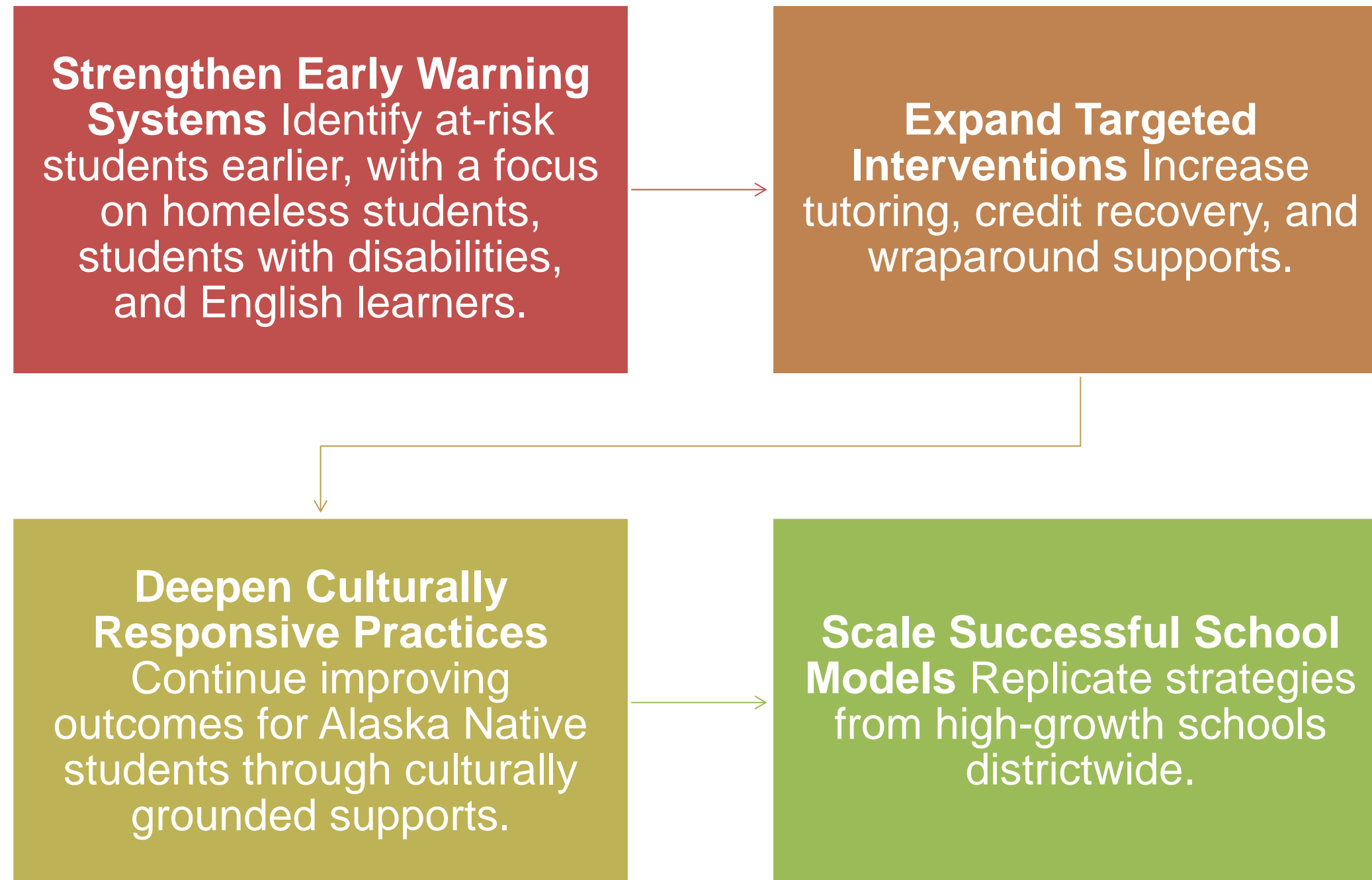
2025 Alaska Native/American Indian Students
