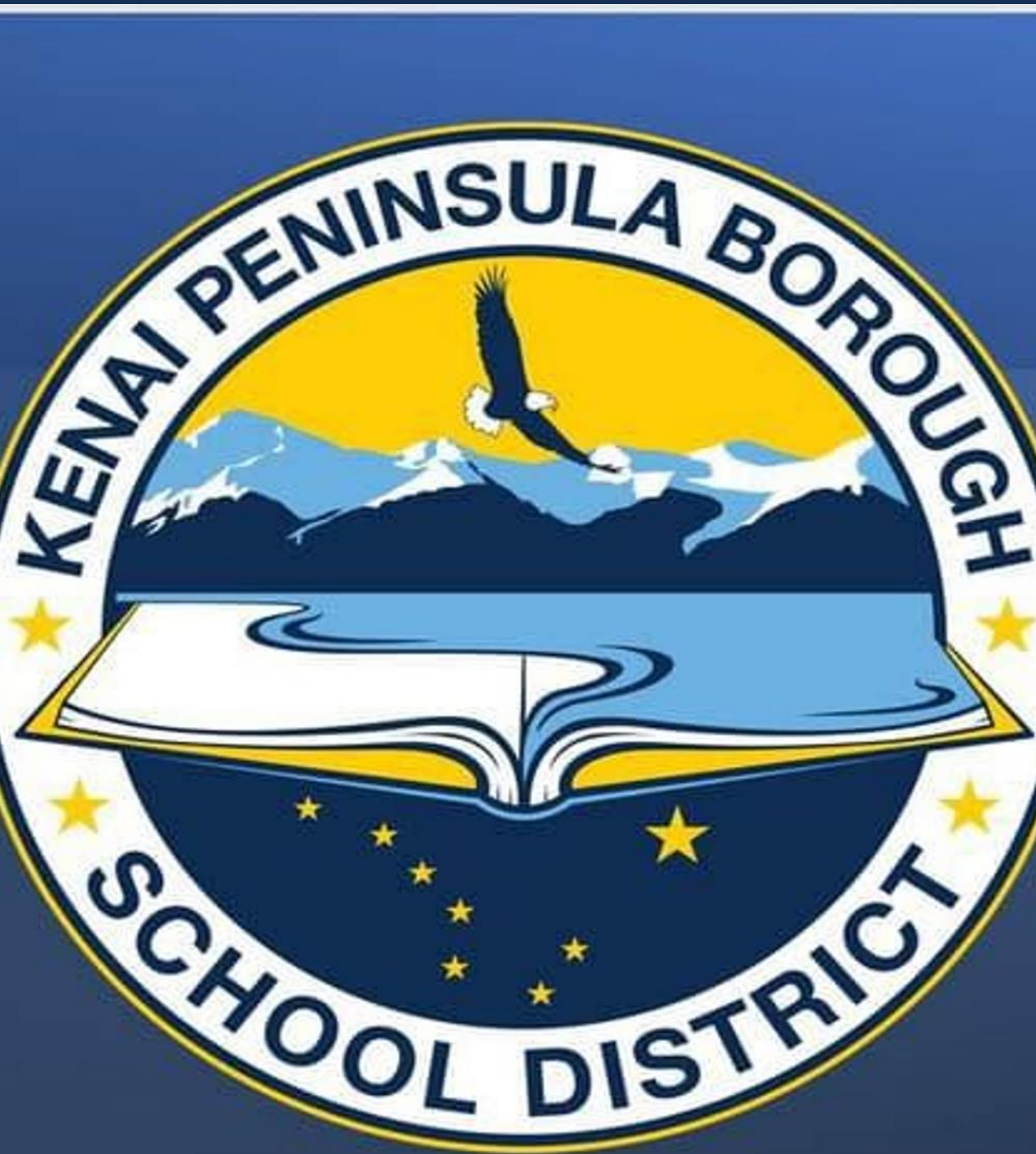

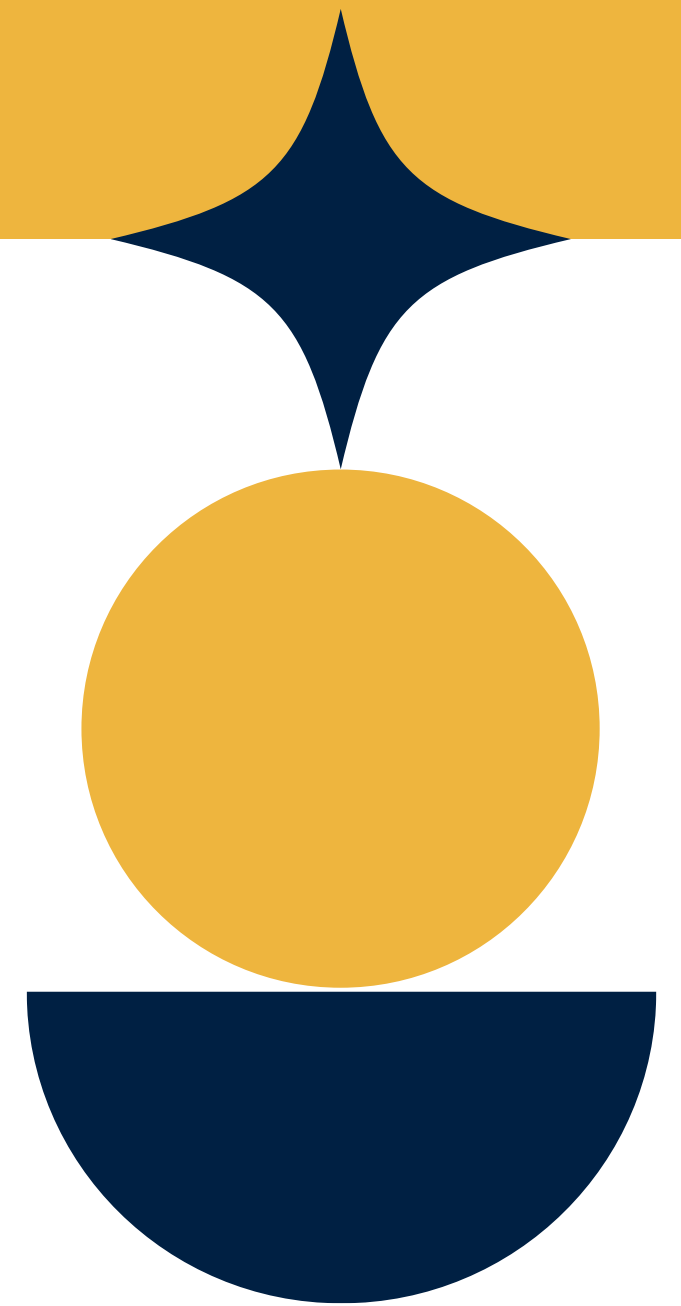

State and Legislative Happenings

One Time State Education Funding

\$115 million in one time education funding finalized August 31

- KPBSD will receive the funding level anticipated in our FY27 budget
- Avoids an additional reduction in anticipated revenue
- Provides important stability for the current year

AI and Student Technology

- KPBSD has established clear guardrails and practices that promote transparency, academic honesty, student safety, and responsible use of technology
- Technology should support strong teaching and student learning.
- It should not replace teacher interaction, student thinking, writing, discussion, or problem solving.
- Technology must be used transparently, with parent knowledge and involvement, and in ways that protect student privacy and well-being.

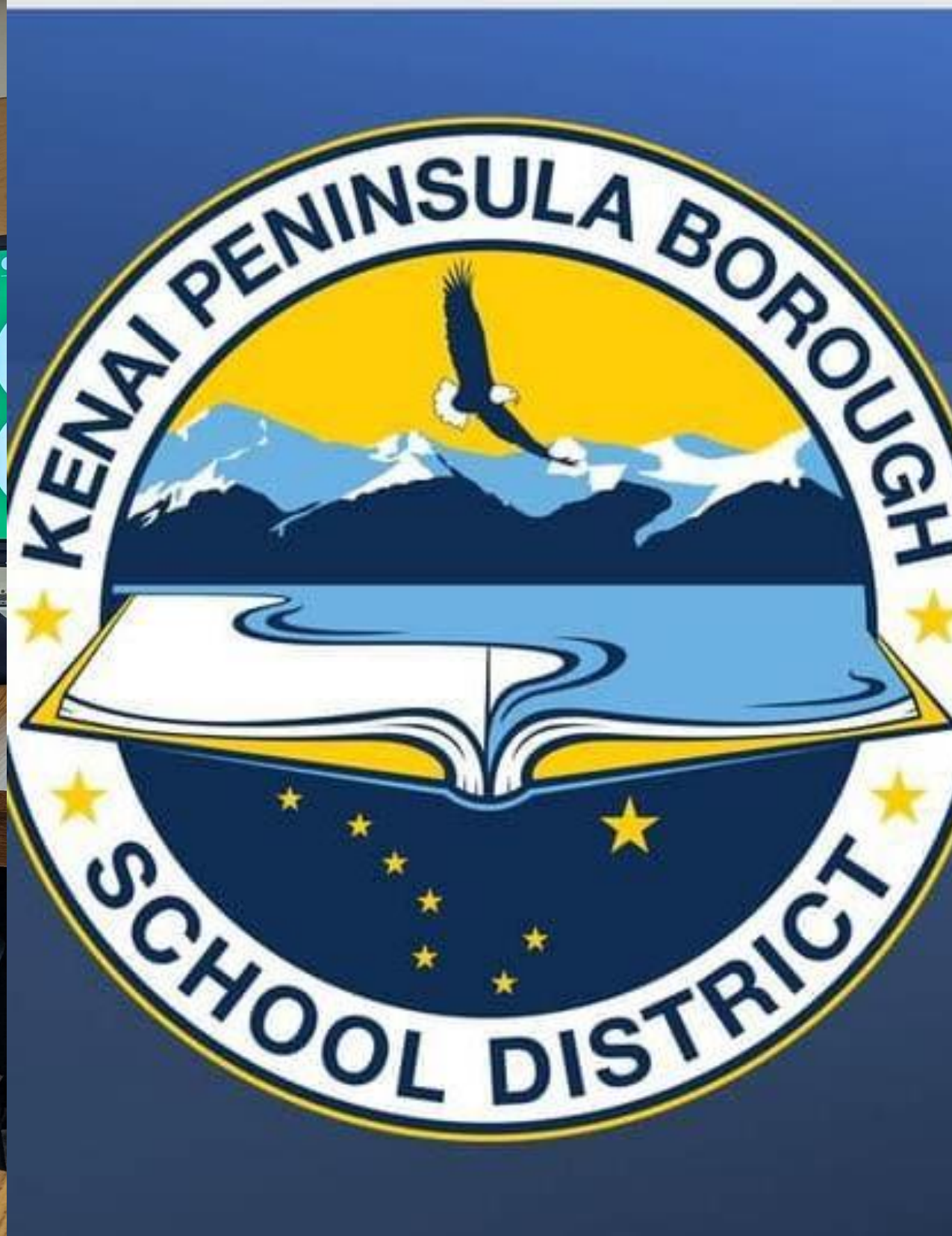
