I taught ten years at Cedaredge High School in Delta County, Colorado. There I introduced Advanced Placement (AP) Chemistry and AP Biology. I sponsored Science Fair projects that qualified students for the International Science and Engineering Fairs for five years. I coached the Knowledge Bowl team for nine years that were the 1991 3A State Champions.

I have served on many Kenai Peninsula Borough School District committees including the Health Care Program committee.




Dear Sean,
