Approval to Take High School Level Algebra I/Geometry at the Middle School

In accordance with AR 6146.1 High School Graduation, “middle school students may receive high school credit for Algebra I/Geometry upon successful completion (with a grade of C or better), even if taken at the middle school.”

Your student has been selected/recommended to take high school level Algebra I/Geometry as a middle school student. Even though the course will be taught at the middle school, it is a high school class. If your student passes with a grade of C or higher in both Semesters 1 and 2, the grade will go on their high school transcript and count towards their high school grade point average (GPA). (Both semesters must be passed with a grade of C or higher or no credit will be awarded).

- At the end of Semester 1, Students who do not earn at least a C will automatically be dropped from Algebra I/Geometry. (They will be placed back into 8th grade Math.)*
- A student may also be dropped by either recommendation of the school or request of the parent.*
- Only students who earn a grade of C or higher for both Semester 1 and Semester 2 will earn high school credit and have the course count towards their high school grade point average (GPA) on the high school transcript.*

I understand that Algebra I/Geometry taken at the middle school is a high school level class that will go on my student’s high school transcript and count towards their high school grade point average (GPA). I have read all of the information above and wish for my student to be enrolled in the high school level Algebra/Geometry class that the middle school is offering.
