

2017 AASB Resolutions

Issues the KPBSD Board has considered in the past:

- 1.1 Opposing Mandated District or Local School Consolidation – Sunsets in 2017, but proposed to be extended. Legislative Finance did an informal study and found little savings
- 1.2 Opposition to Mandated Borough Formation – Sunsets in 2017
- 2.18 Statutory Grounds for Reduction in Force – Sunsets in 2018
- 2.26 Recommending revisions to the step-down hold-harmless clause for reductions in ADM – Sunsets in 2018. Current threshold is 5%, recommending 2.5% from one fiscal year to the next.
- 4.7 Relating to defined benefit retirement – Sunsets in 2020. Supports establishment of a revenue neutral defined benefit retirement program
- 5.19 Supporting Authentic Assessments – Sunsets in 2020. Development of performance task assessments at the district level.
- 5.20 Supporting easier access to charter school programs – Sunsets in 2021. Expand enrollment system to include a weighted lottery.

Also, there are 3 new resolutions being proposed by the AASB Board of Directors along with 35 resolutions that will sunset this year. AASB recommends adoption of the new resolutions along with extending the 35 resolutions that are scheduled to sunset this year.
